She reviewed FY 2014-2015, 22 FY 2016-2017, and FY 2018-2019. The licensee count 23 was 22,908, but with a recent additional 400, the

total increased to 23,308. She mentioned current

growth in the licensee population with an additional

2,411 licensees compared to FY 2014-2015.

Ms. Adams stated 94.2% of revenue was from renewals and applications. She discussed the current biennial total.

Ms. Adams reviewed the categorical breakdown of administrative and legal expenses for FY 2016-2017 and FY 2017-2018, the FY 2018-2019 budget, and FY 2018-2019 expenses. She noted a recent increase in expenses. She commented that the current budget was adequate for FY 2018-2019.

Ms. Adams addressed revenues and expenses from FY 2016-2017, FY 2017-2018, and FY 2018-2019, as well as the budget balance.

Chair Cardone questioned why the cost of prosecution was on track to double over the next two or three years. Ms. McCarthy explained that an additional prosecutor was assigned to the Board's cases due to the approximately 10% increase in the number of cases, as well as the costs of expert fees.

Ms. Adams provided a breakdown of Board member expenses for FY 2016-2017 and FY 2017-2018, noting a budget for FY 2018-2019. She discussed the expenses as of March 19. She noted that the budget will remain the same for FY 2019-2020. She commented that any excess goes back to the restricted account for the

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Board's use.

Ms. Adams reviewed the expenditure sheet providing a pictorial overview of the fluctuation in expenses since 2006.

Ms. Adams addressed the negative balance. She noted the process of fee increases and the anticipated Bachelor of Social Work would increase the Board's revenue.]
