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It was noted that Dr. Corby had requested that no decisions be made on the matter until after the September meeting. Ms. Wucinski suggested placing a notice on the website after the September meeting.

Ms. Wucinski reviewed the complaint process. She explained that prosecutors must rely on the regulations in the act in order to file charges. She noted that the regulations do not prohibit an LSW from practicing independently.

Ms. Wucinski addressed supervision and individuals working towards licensure. She discussed the responsibility for treatment procedures being on the supervisors.

Ms. Martin commented that the LSW licensure is a provisional license based on graduation from a school of social work, passing a licensing exam, and applying for the LSW. The licensure does not include any amount of supervised work after graduation.

Ms. Martin stated LCSW includes supervised work, noting that an individual may practice independently. She noted that as one of the main differences between the LSW and LCSW.

Ms. Wucinski added that nowhere in the act or regulations is an LSW referred to as a provisional license. Nowhere in the practice of social work

definition is an individual prohibited from practicing independently as an LSW.

Chair Cardone stated that diagnosis is limited to the LCSW, and an LSW cannot diagnose, which limits the degree to which an LSW can be in private practice. She commented that a further review of the bill is necessary.

Dr. Jordal reviewed the supervisor's responsibilities regarding the business and ethics aspect of an independent practice.

Chair Cardone noted the need for distinction between supervisor as in consultative supervisor and a supervisor towards licensure, noting that the regulation clearly states that the supervisor towards licensure is responsible for the candidate's practice.

Ms. Wucinski suggested placing Senate Bill 530 on the agenda for later review.

Ms. Matter clarified the supervised clinical experience requirements for marriage and family therapists and professional counselors, which will now allow an individual to obtain their supervised clinical experience after obtaining their master's degree instead of after the completion of 48 semester credits or 72 quarter credits which is required in the regulations at this time. She indicated that
