   any interpretation that enables a LSW to operate an
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independent social work practice under the supervision of an LCSW as it would not assert necessary behavioral and financial control. Mr. Andrews commented that the Board's interpretation would generate excessive liability and risk to the LCSW.

Mr. Brindle provided a brief summary of his professional background. He reiterated that NASW-PA asserts that a LCSW in independent practice who is receiving outside contractual clinical licensure supervision would be in direct violation of the provisions outlined in Act 76. He noted that a solution should be offered to LSWs who have practiced independently for decades and are within 60 months of closing their practices. He discussed several alternatives.

Chair Cardone commented on her understanding that the legislation speaks to the independent practice of social work and that a BSW and MSW could both be in independent practice but neither could do clinical practices. She clarified that the independent practice of clinical social work was limited to LCSWs.

Mr. Andrews commented on the practice differences between a LSW and LCSW. Board members had questions and comments concerning the 60-month time frame, supervision, current language in the Act and Board
