the legislature in Pennsylvania. She mentioned that
no substantive changes should be made to the model
language and that any substantive changes may
jeopardize the enacting state's participation in the
compact.

Ms. Miley stated The Council of State Governments
National Center for Interstate Compacts reviews the
state compact legislation to ensure consistency with
the model language and to direct any inquiries to
Jessica Thomas.

Chair Santiago asked how everything fits together with where the organization is at when looking at their licensure exam function.

Johanna Byrd, ACSW, IOM, CAE, Executive Director, National Association of Social Workers, explained that the National Association of Social Workers came out officially against the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB) Exam in its current form because of the struggles with equity and the diverse populations who were negatively impacted by the exam.

Ms. Byrd explained that some states have eliminated the exam requirement for some of the lower licenses, which would be the equivalent of the LSW in Pennsylvania. She mentioned that they were willing to come out against the compact in general, along

with motivating some revisions to the language,
noting states have done that or have alternative
pathways to licensure, which is another option being
explored.

- Ms. Byrd stated they would actually be accepted or at least are not explicitly excluded under the compact language. She mentioned that was the main issue NASW was holding out for and since then has come out full force for the compact.
- Ms. Byrd reported several states are in the process but none have passed legislation. She mentioned that Illinois and Rhode Island eliminated the LSW exam, and there may be a couple of others in the process of making that change. She noted Wisconsin is in the process of defining an alternative pathway, where they are not eliminating the exam but may have an alternative pathway by gaining additional supervised hours for obtaining their license.
- Ms. Martin asked who would review everything for any sort of conflict with Pennsylvania license regulations.
- Ms. Miley informed Board members that she would be responsible for review but noted that the next step does not take place until it is actually in
