Ms. Kotsalos discussed the role of Banking and Securities. She stated the Department regulates all of the financial institutions in Pennsylvania. She educates the community on fraud abuse and the reporting of fraud abuse.

Ms. Getgen noted there has been a significant increase in elder abuse over the past ten years. Ms. Getgen discussed the "red flags" including impaired decision-making, isolation, missed appointments, medication issues, and self-neglect.

The Pennsylvania Law mandates the Older Adults

Protective Service Act and voluntary reporting. Ms.

Getgen noted immunity for people who are reporting in good faith and sanctions for those who fail to report.

Ms. Getgen stated concerned citizens should contact their local Area Agency on Aging who will assess the situation and send an investigator.

Ms. Kotsalos informed the Board of a free continuing education training program for medical and social professionals. There were questions and comments by Board members.]
