

STIPULATED FACTS

5. Respondent admits that the following allegations are true:
 - a. Respondent's last known business address is 1501 McDaniel Drive, West Chester, PA 19380.
 - b. West Chester Area Senior Center is a charitable organization that is registered with the Bureau, certificate number 15013.
 - c. The Bureau received evidence that Respondent performed professional fundraising counsel services for West Chester Area Senior Center pursuant to a written contract between Respondent and West Chester Area Senior Center beginning on or about March 1, 2011.
 - d. At all relevant and material times, there was no approved contract on file with the Bureau between Respondent and West Chester Area Senior Center.

AGREED VIOLATIONS

6. Respondent admits and agrees that by engaging in the foregoing activities:
 - a. Respondent violated the Act at 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1), by and through 10 P.S. § 162.8(d), by failing to file Respondent's contract with West Chester Area Senior Center with the Bureau prior to rendering professional fundraising counsel services; and
 - b. Respondent repeatedly violated the Act at 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1), by and through 10 P.S. § 162.8(a), by providing professional fundraising counsel services prior to being registered as a professional fundraising counsel with the Bureau.

PROPOSED ORDER

7. The participants, intending to be legally bound, consent to the issuance of the following Order in settlement of this matter:

a. Respondent violated the Act at 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1), by and through §162.8(d); and

b. Respondent repeatedly violated the Act at 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1), by and through 10 P.S. § 162.8(a).

ADMINISTRATIVE FINE

c. An **ADMINISTRATIVE FINE** of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) is levied upon Respondent. Respondent shall tender the full sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), with this executed Consent Agreement which shall be paid by **certified check, cashiers check, attorney's check, or U.S. Postal money order made payable to the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania."** Respondent shall also pay any and all currently outstanding Administrative Fines levied by the Bureau's registration unit.

FILING OF REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

d. Respondent shall submit to the Bureau all documents required to initially register within fifteen (15) days of the date of the Secretary's Order adopting this Consent Agreement. Respondent is prohibited from providing professional fundraising counseling services in Pennsylvania until such time as the Respondent becomes properly registered with the Bureau.

FILING OF CONTRACTS

e. Respondent shall submit to the Bureau any and all overdue contracts and campaign financial reports within thirty (30) days of the date of the Secretary's Order adopting this Consent Agreement. In the event that the campaign reports are not filed within the required time frame, the Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of \$1,000.00, and shall pay an additional penalty of \$100.00 for each day during which the violation continues, in accordance with Section 162.17 of the Act.

CASE SETTLED AND DISCONTINUED

8. This case shall be deemed settled and discontinued upon the Secretary issuing an Order adopting this Consent Agreement and the Respondent's successful completion of any ordered discipline. This Consent Agreement resolves all issues contained in the Bureau's Order to Show Cause filed with the Department of State Prothonotary's Office on August 17, 2010.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF NOTICE AND WAIVER OF HEARING

9. Respondent waives the filing of an Order to Show Cause in this matter. Respondent knowingly and voluntarily waives the right to an administrative hearing in this matter, and to the following rights related to that hearing: to be represented by counsel at the hearing; to present witnesses and testimony in defense or in mitigation of any sanction that may be imposed for a violation; to cross-examine witnesses and to challenge evidence presented by the Bureau; to present legal arguments by means of a brief; and to take an appeal from any final adverse decision.

AGREEMENT NOT BINDING ON OTHER PARTIES

10. This Consent Agreement is between the Bureau and Respondent only. It does not bind any other administrative or governmental entity of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including any other bureau within the Department of State. Except as otherwise noted, this Agreement is to have no legal effect if (a) the Office of General Counsel expresses an objection to the Agreement's form or legality and/or (b) unless and until the Secretary issues the stipulated Order.

EFFECT OF SECRETARY'S REJECTION

11. Should the Secretary not approve this Consent Agreement, presentation to and consideration of this Consent Agreement and other documents and matters by the Secretary shall

not prejudice the Secretary from further participation in the adjudication of this matter. This paragraph is binding on the participants even if the Secretary does not approve this Consent Agreement.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

12. This Agreement contains the whole agreement between the parties; provided, however, that the captions printed in the various provisions of this agreement are for ease of reading only and are not to be interpreted as forming any part of this agreement. There are no other terms, obligations, covenants, representations, statements or conditions, or otherwise, of any kind whatsoever, concerning this Agreement.

AGREEMENT DOES NOT PREVENT REFERRAL TO OTHER AGENCIES

13. The parties acknowledge that other federal, state, and/or local agencies may have jurisdiction over the activities of, or representations made by, Respondent. Nothing in this Consent Agreement or the Order based upon this Consent Agreement shall preclude representatives of the Bureau from referring any information or data produced as a result of this matter to any federal, state, or local agency or governmental unit having jurisdiction over the activities of Respondent.


VERIFICATION OF FACTS AND STATEMENTS
