

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS February 2022

Acting Secretary of State Leigh M. Chapman announced that 4 disciplinary actions have been taken against charitable organizations, professional solicitors and professional fundraising counsel by the Bureau of Corporations and Charitable Organizations.

In State

Philadelphia County

The African American Museum in Philadelphia, Philadelphia, PA, paid a \$6,000.00 administrative fine as the result of soliciting contributions from May 16, 2016, through the present, without the approved registration filed with the Bureau after it received contributions in excess of \$25,000.00 per annum in violation of 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1). (2/28/2022).

Jastech Development Services, Inc., Philadelphia, PA, paid a \$2,000.00 administrative fine as the result of soliciting contributions during its 2017 and 2019 fiscal years, without the approved registration filed with the Bureau after it received contributions in excess of \$25,000.00 per annum in violation of 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1). (2/28/2022).

The Turning Points for Children, Philadelphia, PA, paid a \$4,000.00 administrative fine as the result of soliciting contributions from May 15, 2018, through May 15, 2021, without the approved registration filed with the Bureau after it received contributions in excess of \$25,000.00 per annum in violation of 10 P.S. § 162.15(a)(1). (2/28/2022).
