McCarrin, DC, Chair, called the meeting to 11 order at 9:08 a.m. George E. Khoury, DC, Secretary, was not present at the commencement of the meeting.] 12 13 * * * 14 Approval of Minutes of the March 23, 2017 meeting 15 CHAIR MCCARRIN: Is there a motion for the minutes? 16 17 MS. VANORDER: 18 Motion to approve the minutes as 19 drafted. 20 MS. WOODS: 21 Second. 22 CHAIR MCCARRIN: 23 All in favor? 24 [The motion carried unanimously.] * * * 25

Report of Board Prosecutor 1 2 [Anita Shekletski, Esquire, Board Prosecution Liaison, 3 presented VRP Consent Agreements for File No. 17-43-00283 and File No. 17-43-01532.] 4 * * * 5 6 [David Schertz, Esquire, presented a Consent Agreement 7 for File No. 15-43-07279.] * * * 8 9 [George E. Khoury, DC, Secretary, entered the meeting 10 at 9:10 a.m.] * * * 11 Report of Commissioner 12 [Ian Harlow, Commissioner of Professional and 13 14 Occupational Affairs, provided updates on the 15 Pennsylvania Automated License System (PALS). Не 16 explained the funds set to expire at the end of this 17 fiscal year were used to buy new PCs and peripherals for the staff. 18 19 Mr. Harlow discussed Board appointments, new 20 board member training, and answered questions from 21 Board members.] * * * 22 23 Report of Board Counsel 24 [Kerry Maloney, Esquire, Board Counsel, noted matters 25 for the Board's deliberation during Executive Session.

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He further noted a provisional denial hearing 1 2 scheduled for 10:30 a.m. 3 Mr. Maloney stated Charles Artz, Esquire, would 4 address the Board at 11:00 a.m. with regard to animal 5 chiropractic scope of practice.] * * * 6 7 Report of Board Chairperson 8 [John E. McCarrin, Chair, stated, as a first-time 9 Chair, he will address Board members' concerns and 10 issues.] * * * 11 12 Report of Board Administrator [Elizabeth Wecker, Board Administrator, noted a CE 13 14 Waiver Request, Application for License by Exam and an 15 Application for License by Reciprocity to be discussed 16 during Executive Session.] * * * 17 New Business 18 19 [Dr. Khoury, DC, Secretary, thanked the Board for 20 appointing him and Dr. Halloran as delegates to the regional conference recently held in Orlando. 21 22 He discussed utilizing radio and television to 23 promote chiropractic medicine. 24 Dr. Khoury presented his FCLB report. He also 25 highlighted the effective use of Consent Agreements.

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Dr. Khoury provided highlights of the PACE program. 1 Dr. Halloran added comments with regard to 2 3 required criminal background checks, which he 4 suggested should be a requirement for new licensees.] * * * 5 6 DR. HALLORAN: 7 I make a motion that Dr. Khoury and I accept the invitation to attend the FCLB 8 9 Regional District III meeting in Quebec 10 City, Quebec, scheduled for the weekend 11 of September 14-17, 2017. 12 DR. SWANK: Second. 13 CHAIR MCCARRIN: 14 All in favor? 15 16 [The motion carried unanimously.] * * * 17 18 [Dr. Swank reported on his attendance at a recent 19 seminar and discussed the latest research on pain 20 management and chiropractic manipulation.] * * * 21 22 [Dr. Khoury discussed coaches and athletic trainers 23 not qualified to take care of athletes in dangerous 24 situations. 25 It was suggested that the PIAA be invited to

present before the Board concerning the matter. 1 2 Mr. Maloney explained the PIAA was abiding by state law rules and guidelines. It was suggested that 3 4 correspondence be sent to the PIAA regarding its 5 sports concussion protocol. It was also suggested 6 that Bill Moreau, USOC, be invited to a future Board 7 meeting to provide input on the matter.] * * * 8 9 [The Board continued its discussion relating to PACE 10 courses and programs. Dr. Halloran suggested voting 11 on the matter at the next meeting in July 2017. 12 Mr. Maloney suggested Elizabeth Wecker, Board 13 Administrator, be explicitly directed to review and 14 accept PACE-approved courses. He also discussed PACE 15 advertisement. 16 Mr. Maloney suggested a vote be taken to send criteria to PACE and then at the Board's next meeting 17 18 finalize and give authority for the committee to 19 approve the PACE-approved programs. 20 Commissioner Harlow expressed his concerns regarding the receipt of credits electronically. 21 He 22 suggested a global provider of CE registration at some 23 point in the future across all boards, which he noted 2.4 may or may not be PACE.] 25 * * *
