He 18 explained, under the Regulatory Review Act, 19 certifications would be required with regard to the 20 emergency regulation and it would take too long to 21 start an emergency regulation. 22 Mr. Maloney also explained that the Board's role 23 is to protect the citizens of the Commonwealth and not 24 the practice of a licensee. It was noted that the 25 Puerto Rican doctors could apply for licensure by
