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11 Discussion Items

[Sean Barrett, Esquire, Board Counsel, addressed 16A-4520 regarding fees. He believed the fee increases would be published and final by the next renewal

15 period in January.

Ms. Eaton informed Board members renewal notices would be going out around Thanksgiving.

Mr. Barrett addressed the career and technology center (CTC) pilot program that was signed into law July 8, 2022. He mentioned the Board previously had a pilot program but addressed some minor changes regarding distance education, including allowing students in CTC schools to gain real-life experience through job shadowing internships under the guidance of a program educator that also compensates students.

Mr. Barrett stated that the CTC programs themselves have to provide certain information to the Board in order to track progress of the program to see who is utilizing it. He noted the statute allows the Board to seek information the Board wants other than what is statutorily required.

Mr. Barrett encouraged Board members to start pondering what other information should be tracked for successful progress of the pilot program. He explained that the life of the program is for the next three years, and the legislature would like feedback regarding many people are utilizing the program and requested the Board provide the information by June 30, 2023. He mentioned wanting to provide the programs with the form and placing the issue back on the agenda for the next meeting.

Mr. Barrett addressed Senate Bill 1287 that would reduce the footage requirements in a spa from 180 feet to 120 feet. He informed Board members the bill is currently on the House floor and up for second consideration from the Appropriations Committee. He would to keep the Board updated on the bill.]
