25 Janette Zellers, Divisional Vice President,

- Empire Beauty Schools, requested clarity regarding 1 2 licenses being issued before students graduate. 3 stated approximately 109 students have passed their 4 test, and the license has been labeled as issued as 5 of the date they passed the test. She requested 6 information concern the process, where they do not 7 meet the requirements for obtaining their license because they have not earned 1250 hours and have not been certified as a graduate.
  - Mr. Hinsey asked whether Ms. Zellers was referring to temporary authority to practice while students complete their hours.

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- Ms. Zellers explained that it is not their temporary license and is the license issued on the website and offered to provide examples.
- Ms. Eaton stated the license has to be issued in accordance with the date they passed their exam, and if it is an early exam, then it goes by the date of the completion of their final hours.
- Ms. Zellers expressed concern and provided an example, where the early licensure exam was on April 19 and the date of license is indicated as April 19 but the student is not a graduate.
- Ms. Eaton stated the student should not have been issued a license if they have not completed the hours

and requested a list be sent to the Board's resource account at st-cosmetology@pa.gov so they are able to address the issue with the company that processes the exam applications.

Anlly Olivares requested information regarding her denial of an extension. She stated she moved from New York to Pennsylvania and needed the 12 months of experience. She mentioned that she followed all of the rules and opened a new business that has an active business license, but she does not have a cosmetology license.

Mr. Hinsey informed Ms. Olivares that she would receive a letter outlining why her motion to extend the provisional license has been denied and she would also have the opportunity to appeal that decision.

Sarah Tillotson, Assistant Stylist, Trouvaille
Salon & Spa, asked whether Velcro rollers were still
illegal in the state of Pennsylvania.

Mr. Hinsey noted that he was not aware of that status being changed.

Addison Altland asked whether someone could rent a booth space as a nail technician or esthetician in a barbershop.

Mr. Hinsey recommended Ms. Altland refer that question to the State Board of Barber Examiners
