Examinations are administered as computer based tests (CBT) through the Pearson VUE testing centers. Within 4-10 weeks of the Board receiving an application, the candidate will be assigned a 90-day examination window and scheduling instructions from ARRT.

State examination scores will be counted in an individual's number of ARRT examination attempts. State candidates who sit for the examination in Nuclear Medical Technology, Radiation Therapy Technology or Radiography will have those attempts counted toward ARRT's "three times in three years" eligibility requirement should they later apply for ARRT certification.

An individual's state-examination score will not count for ARRT certification. In addition, state examination scores (first attempt) will be counted in ARRT's educational program statistics.
