- 4 House Bill 1356 regarding music therapists. She
- 5 noted the bill is seeking to have music therapists
- 6 governed by the Board and be licensed and regulated
- 7 by the Board.
- 8 Ms. Miley stated House Bill 1398 also seeks to
- 9 have professional art therapists be licensed and
- 10 regulated under the Board.
- 11 Chair Santiago referred to 16A-6925, noting
- 12 language in Act 41 states the language current
- 13 applicable law and asked what that means to people
- 14 who received a degree in 2009 when the law was
- 15 different.
- 16 Ms. Miley explained that individuals would still
- 17 | fall under Act 41 because it is the current
- 18 legislative mandate.
- 19 Chair Santiago commented that the expectation of
- 20 music therapists and art therapists is to fall under
- 21 | the Board and called registered and/or certified art
- 22 therapists.
- Ms. Miley stated it is adding a licensure
- 24 category under the regulation of the Board and is
- 25 currently in the bill.

Andrew LaFratte, MPA, Deputy Policy Director,
Department of State, informed Board members that the
Office of Policy is in the process of reviewing a
Sunrise Application for the art therapy license class
submitted by the Pennsylvania Art Therapy
Association.

Ms. Martin referred to House Bill 1356 Section 7(4), where the applicant remains actively certified by the Certification Board for Music Therapists, noting that none of the other professions on the Board have the requirement to be certified by any outside agencies and questioned why they would need that in their act.

Ms. Martin commented that there is confusion in both the acts regarding language and whether it is being changed. She referred to House Bill 1398, using language that "he or she" shall first have obtained and holds "himself or herself" forth. She mentioned that it should be consistent throughout the revisions if changing it to "the person," which is gender neutral.

Ms. Miley explained that the Board cannot revise those because they are not regulations but could be passed along to the legislature.]
