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expenses for FY 2018-2019 and FY 2019-2020 with a 24 current budget for FY 2020-2021 and expenses as of 25 March 1, 2021. She noted the current expenses.

Column E shows the expenses as of 3/1/2021 which were \$991,690.21 and as of this morning increased to \$1,102,059.30, an increase of \$110,369.09. As we are currently about ¾ of the way through the year, I feel the budget of \$1,787,000.00 should be sufficient.

Ms. Adams reviewed revenues and expenses for FY 2020-2021. She noted anticipated income from the licensed bachelor and the current bottom line. She stated the Board should be back in the black by the projected year.
