Ms. Miley noted scammers are altering information on caller ID to appear to be from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and threatening license suspension for failure to act and falsely claiming involvement with federal agencies, such as the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

Ms. Miley stated scammers are known to threaten license suspension for failure to provide personal information. She provided reminders from BPOA concerning contact and personal information for licensees and applicants.

Ms. Miley noted licensees would never be contacted by phone for payment. She reminded everyone to never provide personal or financial information over the phone, text message, or fax. She mentioned that those who are the subject of an investigation or disciplinary action will receive notice by certified mail and/or personal service and are provided with a contact name and phone number. She informed everyone to contact their local police department or the Pennsylvania State Police if they have been a victim of the scam.]
