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**SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELEASES STATE
BUSINESS LICENSING BOARDS ACTIONS - (1st Quarter 2006)**

HARRISBURG (May 4, 2005) – Commonwealth Secretary Pedro A. Cortés and Basil L. Merenda, Commissioner of the State Department's Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs today announced 92 disciplinary actions taken by the following state boards in the first quarter of 2006: Accountancy; Architects; Auctioneer Examiners; Barber Examiners; Certified Real Estate Appraisers; Cosmetology; Funeral Directors; Landscape Architects; and Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists.

Actions were taken against individuals or firms in the following counties: Allegheny (11 actions); Beaver (1 action); Berks (1 action); Bradford (1 action); Bucks (7 actions); Butler (2 actions); Chester (6 actions); Cumberland (1 action); Dauphin (2 actions); Delaware (3 actions); Fayette (3 actions); Franklin (1 action); Greene (1 action); Huntingdon (1 action); Lackawanna (1 action); Lancaster (4 actions); Luzerne (3 actions); Mercer (1 action); Mifflin (1 action); Montgomery (7 actions); Northampton (3 actions); Philadelphia (19 actions); Somerset (1 action); Washington (1 action); Westmoreland (2 actions); and York (4 actions). A total of four actions involved Pennsylvania licenses with out-of-state addresses.

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2006

The State Board of Accountancy imposed the following sanctions:

Bruce J. Beard (certificate no. CA-029089-L), of Uniontown, Fayette County, had his certificate of certified public accountant revoked for failing to comply with a prior disciplinary order that directed him to pay civil penalties totaling \$6,000. Mr. Beard was ordered to either surrender his previously suspended certificate or certify that the certificate was lost, misplaced or stolen. (08-25-05)

Kara Piscopo, formerly Kara Guinan (certificate no. CA-038072-L), of Media, Delaware County, was assessed a \$500 civil penalty and ordered to complete 10 hours of make-up continuing education. Ms. Piscopo failed to fulfill her continuing education requirement for the 2000-2001 reporting period. (12-21-05)

David C. Smith, CPA (certificate no. CA-017489-L) of Kennett Square, Chester County, was assessed a \$1,000 civil penalty and ordered to complete 11 hours of make-up continuing education. Mr. Smith failed to fulfill his continuing education requirement for the 2000-2001 reporting period. (12-21-05)

Linda M. Costello, CPA (certificate no. CA-028653-L), of Latrobe, Westmoreland County, was assessed a \$4,000 civil penalty for practicing public accounting without a current license. (12-23-05)

Craig F. Kirsch, CPA (certificate no. CA-046640), of Wexford, Allegheny County, had his certificate of certified public accountant and current license revoked, effective January 23, 2006. Mr. Kirsch was assessed an \$8,000 civil penalty because he had held himself out as a certified public accountant prior to becoming credentialed by the board. The case is currently on appeal to Commonwealth Court. (12-23-05)

Susan Kay Grumer, license no. CA-020278-L of Exton, Chester County was assessed a civil penalty of \$900. Ms. Grumer practiced public accounting when she was not licensed to do so; her license had expired on April 30, 2000 (01-17-06)

Joseph E. Mendola (certificate no. CA-019191-L), of Charleroi, Washington County, had his certificate of certified public accountant suspended and was assessed a \$3,000 civil penalty. Mr. Mendola practiced public accounting without a current license. Reinstatement of Mendola's certificate is conditioned on his payment of the civil penalty and meeting the requirements for current licensure. (01-17-06)

Kenneth J. Stutz, license no. CA-009093-L of Lancaster, Lancaster County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$3000 because he practiced public accounting after April 30, 2000 and before September 16, 2004. Mr. Stutz's license had expired on April 30, 2000. (01-17-06)

Thomas J. McLaughlin (certificate no. CA-023536-L), of Glen Mills, Delaware County, was assessed a \$1,000 civil penalty for representing himself to be a licensed certified public accountant when he did not possess a current license. (01-18-06)

Mark J. Riley, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, had his application for a certificate of certified public accountant denied because he lacked satisfactory experience. (01-18-06)

Joseph C. Calabro, Jr., CPA (certificate no. CA-014573-L), of Devon, Chester County, was reprimanded and assessed a \$500 civil penalty for failing to exercise due professional care in a public accounting engagement. (01-24-06)

Miller & Miller CPAs, LLP (license no. AF-000434-L), of Lancaster, Lancaster County, had charges that it violated professional standards for its modification of the terms of a client engagement dismissed. (01-24-06)

The State Board of Architects Licensure imposed the following sanctions:

Mark E. Honchell, license no. RA-006842-X of Towanda, Bradford County, paid a civil penalty of \$1,000 because Honchell engaged in the practice of architecture on an expired license. (03-16-06)

Melham Associates, PC, license no. AX-001238-L of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, paid a civil penalty of \$4,000 because it permitted its Director of Architecture to supervise architectural projects without being a shareholder of its professional corporation. (03-16-06)

The State Board of Auctioneer Examiners imposed the following sanctions:

Ian J. Gilmore, license no. AA-002712-L of Belle Vernon, Fayette County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$700. Mr. Gilmore practiced auctioneering when he did not hold a valid auctioneer license. (01-11-06)

James R. Gilmore, license no. AU-000340-L of Belle Vernon, Fayette County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000. Mr. Gilmore practiced auctioneering when he did not hold a valid individual auctioneer's license. (01-11-06)

Robert A. Phillips, license no. AA-002637-L of Pursglove, WV, paid a civil penalty of \$500. Mr. Phillips practiced auctioneering when he did not hold a valid auctioneer license. (03-06-06)

The State Board of Barber Examiners imposed the following sanctions:

Robert Barr, license no. BM-011425-L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on October 17, 2005. The court issued the suspension, effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (11-01-05)

Lester M. Hayes, license no. BM-011213-L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$500 for opening a barber shop without first obtaining an inspection, operating an unlicensed barber shop, and practicing barbering in an unlicensed barber shop. (12-14-05)

Tyrone Stukes, Sr., license no. BL049017L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 21, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-04-06)

Ramon G. Gilmore, license no. BL049415L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas on December 29, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-09-06)

Monte B. Jackson, license no. BL050800L, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was suspended by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas on November 10, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-09-06)

Derrick Wilkerson, license no. BL049704L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 29, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-09-06)

Joseph R. Fareri, license no. BL050168L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 29, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-10-06)

Anthony T. Davis, license no. BL050409L, of Aston, Chester County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 29, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-11-06)

Jeffrey A. Thomas, Sr., license no. BL049409L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Common Pleas of Philadelphia County on December 30, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-12-06)

Eric S. Carter, license no. BL050732L, of McKeesport, Allegheny County, was suspended by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas on December 15, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (02-13-06)

Herbert C. Phillips, license no. BL048927L, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was suspended by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas on December 15, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (02-13-06)

Donald Singleton, license no. BL051932, of McKeesport, Allegheny County, was suspended by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas on December 15, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (02-13-06)

Linda Brown, license no. BO-101390-L of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750 and had a public reprimand placed on her permanent board record. Ms. Brown's barbershop employed three unlicensed individuals, did not have the barbershop's license displayed in a conspicuous place in the barbershop, and disregarded minimum equipment requirements. (02-27-06)

Thomas R. Kay, license no. BL-050690-L of Slippery Rock, Butler County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$100 because Kay continued to practice barbering on a lapsed license. (02-27-06)

Ryan Maus, license no. BL-052263 of York, York County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$350. Mr. Maus held only a temporary license to practice barbering and was not practicing under the supervision of the manager-barber of World A Cuts barbershop. (02-27-06)

Richard Pone of Bristol, Bucks County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$250. Mr. Pone practiced barbering without having first passed an examination to obtain a license. (02-27-06)

The Joseph Segro, Jack Segro, Nancy Segro, & Alfred Segro Barber Shop, license no. BO-048608-L of Lancaster, Lancaster County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750. Mr. Segro failed to display a license for his barber shop, violated the Act regarding maintenance and sanitation, and violated the Act regarding minimum equipment requirements. (02-27-06)

Patrick Winter, license no. BM-011864-L and BO-101262-L of York, York County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$550. Mr. Winter, as manager-barber, was not present to supervise the employees working in his barbershop, employed an unlicensed person, failed to meet the minimum equipment requirements, and performed work in an unsanitary or filthy manner or place of business (02-27-06).

Lester M. Hayes, license no. BM-011213-L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended for failure to pay a civil penalty of \$500. (03-02-06)

Jomo Beatty, d/b/a Jomo & Company, license no. BO-103022-L, of York, York County, was reinstated retroactive to December 5, 2005. (04-12-06)

The State Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers imposed the following sanctions:

Karl Baily, certificate no. RL000996L of Waynesburg, Greene County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750. Mr. Baily was also ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Baily prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (01-12-06)

Geoffrey Blauvelt, certificate no.: RL000534L of Langhorne, Bucks County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Blauvelt prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (01-12-06)

Michael L. Desnoyers, license no. RL-003198-R of Bethlehem, Northampton County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 and successfully complete fifteen (15) hours of continuing education. Mr. Desnoyers failed to prepare an appraisal report in compliance with the USPAP. (01-12-06)

Deborah Ann Differ, certificate no. RL-003237-L of Landenberg, Chester County, received a public reprimand. Ms. Differ received other disciplinary action by the appraisal certification authority of another state. (01-12-06)

Kenneth V. Gardner, temporary practice certificate nos. 001348, 001360, & 001439 of Ithaca, NY, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000. Mr. Gardner performed real estate appraisals without the required certificate. (01-12-06)

Kirk V. Gosweiler, certificate no.: RL003294L of Downingtown, Chester County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$500 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Gosweiler prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (01-12-06)

John K. Laskey, certificate no.: RL002008L of Harleysville, Montgomery County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Laskey prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (01-12-06)

Vincent A. Pacella of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$4,000. Mr. Pacella performed an appraisal without a valid and active appraisal certificate. (01-12-06)

Gennaro A. Porco, certificate no.: RL001965R of Westville, New Jersey was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Porco prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (01-12-06)

Thomas V. Bianco, D.C., license no. DC005690L, of Chadds Ford, Delaware County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,200 and successfully complete 24 credit hours of continuing education. Mr. Bianco failed to submit proof of completion of at least 24 credit hours of continuing education in acceptable courses taken between September 2, 2002 and September 1, 2004. (01-26-06)

Gerard L. Da Via, certificate no.: GA000816L of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750. Mr. Da Via failed to personally make an interior and exterior inspection of the subject property and created a misleading appraisal report indicating he had inspected the interior of the Gifford Street Property when he did not. (02-09-06)

Robert Reimold, certificate nos.: RL003457L & BA000572L of Tranfer, Mercer County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Reimold prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (02-09-06)

Nicholas A. Salamone, certificate no.: BA000810L of Plymouth Meeting, Montgomery County voluntarily surrendered his appraisal certificate because Salamone prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (02-09-06)

Mark Emanuel Hilbert, certificate no.: RL000388L of Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,500 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Hilbert signed an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (03-09-06)

Louis Victor Martin, certificate no. GA001154L and RL000332 of Latrobe, Westmoreland County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 and to attend 15 hours of additional continuing education. Mr. Martin prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP and failed to adequately supervise an appraisal trainee. (03-09-06)

Kenneth M. Thomas, uncertified, of Butler, Butler County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$500. Mr. Thomas prepared an appraisal report without a current and active appraisal certificate. (03-09-06)

Lori Lyn Carbo, certificate no. RL001639L of Boyertown, Berks County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,750, the costs of prosecution of \$750, and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP and a 7 hour course on summary report writing. Ms. Carbo prepared two appraisal reports that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (4-13-06)

Elden Lange, certificate nos. RL000206L & BA002695L of Hollsopple, Somerset County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 and costs of prosecution of \$500 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Ms. Lange prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (04-13-06)

Morton Schwartz, certificate no.: RL000155L of Willow Grove, Montgomery County was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750, costs of \$500 and ordered to attend an additional 15 hours of continuing education on the USPAP. Mr. Schwartz prepared an appraisal report that did not comply with the requirements of the USPAP. (04-13-06)

The State Board of Cosmetology imposed the following sanctions:

Quy Nguyen, license no. CO221469L, of Bristol, Bucks County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on October 17, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (11-21-05)

Kalsey L. Little, license no. CO250277, of Pottstown, Montgomery County, was suspended by the Montgomery County Court of Common Pleas on October 31, 2005.

The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (11-23-05)

Crystal Lewis, aka Crystal Gallagher, license no. CO250865, of Northampton, Northampton County, was assessed a civil penalty of \$500 in addition to the previous imposed penalty of \$250. MS. Lewis failed to pay a civil penalty. (12-07-05)

Monica L. Reynolds, license no. CL011760L, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was suspended based on her failure to pay the civil penalty imposed by the board. (12-07-05)

Sandra Sullivan, license no. CL178139, of Hatfield, Montgomery County, was suspended based on her failure to pay the civil penalty imposed by the board. (12-07-05)

Hayden W. Smith, Malachi Carter and David R. Brown, license no. CB103956L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was assessed a civil penalty of \$1,500. Mr. Smith operated a shop on a lapsed license, operated a shop without proper management, did not have equipment required at the time of the inspection, did not have the consumer notice posted in the shop and used their shop for purposes other than providing cosmetology services. (12-08-05)

Cindy Phan, unlicensed, of Elkins Park, Montgomery County, was assessed a civil penalty of \$500. Ms. Phan practiced manicuring without a license. (12-08-05)

Eileen D. Regan, license no. CM014636L, of Horsham, Montgomery County, was suspended based on her failure to pay the civil penalty imposed by the board. (12-08-05)

Beatrice Grose, CO236436L and CB108262, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was assessed a civil penalty of \$500 for maintaining an unlicensed shop. (12-13-05)

Angela L. Feola, license no. CO184866L, of West Palm Beach, FL, was suspended by the Lawrence County Court of Common Pleas on November 28, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (12-13-05)

Vickie Russell, license no. CM010967L, of Warminster, Bucks County, was suspended by the Montgomery County Court of Common Pleas on December 19, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-04-06)

Sean Conlin, license no. CO203692L, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was suspended by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas on November 10, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-09-06)

Gregory S. McCowin, Jr., license no. CL016084L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 29,

2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-10-06)

Karin Kovack, license no. CO182107L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was suspended by the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas on December 29, 2005. The court issued the suspension, which was effective immediately, under section 4355 of the Domestic Relations Code. (01-11-06)

Fringe, license no. CB-116975 of Southampton, Bucks County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$2,000. Fringe employed an unlicensed employee, provided manicuring services in a grossly incompetent and unethical manner, altered the physical dimensions of the shop without board approval, used the shop for other purposes aside from the practice of cosmetology, did not use towels in a sanitary manner, and did not use supplies in a sanitary manner. Fringe's non-licensed cosmetology shop employees did not have a physician's certification that they did not have an infectious, contagious, or communicable disease. (02-06-06)

Kiet Ho, license no. CY-109093 of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000. Mr. Ho was offering waxing services to customers, thereby maintaining an unlicensed cosmetology shop. Mr. Ho also was using razor blades, thereby providing pedicures in a grossly incompetent or in an unethical manner. (02-06-06)

Huong Beauty School, license no. CS-001515 of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$250. Huong Beauty School did not maintain appropriate student records. (02-06-06)

John Phan & JP Nails, license nos. CO-236340-L and CY-107156 of Waynesboro, Franklin County, were ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000. Cosmetology services were being performed without a cosmetology license, they failed to maintain instruments in a sanitary condition and were found to possess a tool used for pedicure practices which are services outside the scope of a manicurist's license. (02-06-06)

Alfred L. Segro, license no. CO-198136-L of Lancaster, Lancaster County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$250. Mr. Segro practiced on a lapsed license. (02-06-06)

The Hair Cuttery, license no. CB-087256-L of Feasterville, Bucks County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$650. The Hair Cuttery did not have the required equipment and supplies necessary, did not maintain the shop in a safe, orderly, and sanitary condition, failed to sanitize the equipment immediately after each use, failed to maintain the equipment in a sanitary condition at all times, did not keep unused cloth towels in a closed cabinet and did not use the supplies in a sanitary manner. (02-06-06)

Tina P. Dixon, CO235114L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was assessed a civil penalty of \$250, in addition to the previously imposed civil penalty of \$250. Ms. Dixon failed to pay a civil penalty. (02-08-06)

Helen Ngo Lam, t/d/b/a Regal Nails, license no. CY105725L, of Lewistown, Mifflin County, was assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500. Ms. Lam's use of razor scissors in her manicuring shop constituted gross incompetency or dishonest or unethical practices, failed to supervise an employee holding only a temporary authority to practice manicuring, failed to maintain her manicuring shop in a sanitary condition, and employed an unlicensed employee and maintained an unlicensed cosmetology shop. (02-09-06)

Brenda L. Buckler, license no. CO-193238-L of Plains, Luzerne County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$500. Ms. Buckler practiced cosmetology for compensation in a place other than a licensed cosmetology shop. (04-03-06)

Do Nails, license no. CY-099261-L of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, paid a civil penalty of \$1,000 because she performed cosmetology services in a grossly incompetent or unethical manner. (04-03-06)

Hollywood Nails, license no. CY-102258-L of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, paid a civil penalty of \$1,250. Hollywood Nails did not maintain the shop in a safe, orderly and sanitary condition, did not have current licenses available on the premises, did not sanitize equipment immediately after each use, did not maintain the equipment in a sanitary condition, did not use supplies in a sanitary manner, was performing waxing services without a license, rented booth space within the shop and used the shop for purposes other than those permitted in a manicurists shop. (04-03-06)

Royal Nails, license no. CY-106770 of Hazleton, Luzerne County, paid a civil penalty of \$1,500 because it employed two unlicensed individuals to work in a manicurists shop. (04-03-06)

James Ruggiero of Langhorne, Bucks County, paid a civil penalty of \$500 for practicing cosmetology without a license. (04-03-06)

Kathleen M. Sher, license no. CO-135619-L of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, has paid a civil penalty of \$500 for practicing cosmetology with a lapsed license. (04-03-06)

Lisa A. Smith, license no. CM-013461-L of Todd, Huntingdon County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$1,000 for practicing cosmetology in a place other than a licensed cosmetology shop. (04-03-06)

Young's Nail Salon, license no. CY-098291-L of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, has paid a civil penalty of \$2,250 for employing three unlicensed individuals to work in a manicurists shop. (04-03-06)

The State Board of Funeral Directors imposed the following sanctions:

James M. Stigale, FD, license number FD-013215-L, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$600 for using misleading advertising. Stigale last practiced in Philadelphia. (12-13-05)

Ernest F. Heffner, license no. FD011445L, of Red Lion, York County, was granted a license as funeral supervisor, based upon finding that he is accessible to serve the public at the funeral establishment and that his other activities do not substantially interfere with or prevent his supervision of the funeral establishment. Will T. Leavell, Inc., license number FR-000570-L, of Midland, Beaver County, and license number FB-000222-L, of Beaver Falls, Beaver County, was indefinitely suspended for practicing on a lapsed license and for practicing without a licensed supervisor. (01-06-06)

The State Board of Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists imposed the following sanctions:

Duane M. Policelli, license no. SU-024222-E of Bangor, Northampton County, voluntarily surrendered his license. Mr. Policelli pled guilty to felony charges, and his actions violated Pennsylvania statutes of the CHRIA because he pled guilty to felonies. (05-18-05)

Thomas F. Easton, P.L.S. (license no. SU-020692-E), of Carnegie, Allegheny County, had his professional land surveyor's license and registration revoked and was assessed a \$4,000 civil penalty based on findings that he practiced land surveying without a current license and registration.
