- 12. Last day before the election on which official applications for civilian absentee ballots may be received by the county board of elections July 5, 2016 (*Tuesday before election.*§1302.1 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. §3146.2a(a))

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- A. Political Parties file nomination certificates, nominating candidates in accordance with party rules.
- B. **Independent candidates of political bodies file nomination papers**, obtaining signatures equal to 2% of the largest vote cast for any elected officer in that district at the last preceding election or the number of signatures required on a nomination petition for a political party candidate, whichever is greater. Signers of such papers must be qualified, registered

electors of the district. The number of signatures required on nomination papers to be filed by independent candidates of political bodies for the Special Election for the 168th Legislative District to be held July 12, 2016 is 328. All nomination papers must be accompanied by a properly completed candidate's affidavit and a copy of the Statement of Financial Interests required to be filed with the State Ethics Commission. In addition, a filing fee of \$100.00 must be submitted with each set of nomination papers and must be paid by certified check or money order payable to the 'Commonwealth of Pennsylvania'.
