1. Writ, prepared by presiding officer,

*(At least 60 days prior to the special election. § 628.1 of the Pennsylvania Election Code,
25 P.S. § 2778)*
2. First day for political parties to nominate
candidates by filing nomination certificates. January 6, 2016
(§ 629 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2779)
3. First day for political bodies to circulate and file nomination
papers nominating independent candidates January 6, 2016
(§ 629 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2779)
4. Last day to file nomination certificates and
nomination papers March 7, 2016
*(50 days prior to date of special election. § 629 of the Pennsylvania Election Code,
25 P.S. § 2779)*
5. Last day to file objections: 3 days after deadline for filing March 10, 2016
(§ 632 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2782)
6. Last day for Commonwealth Court to set a hearing
on objections: 7 days after deadline for filing March 14, 2016
(§ 632 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2782)
7. Last day to withdraw: 7 days after the deadline for filing March 14, 2016
(§ 633 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2783)
8. Last day to file substituted nomination
certificates: 7 days after the deadline for filing March 14, 2016
(§ 634(c) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2784(c))
9. Last day to file objections to substituted nominations:
3 days after substituted nomination certificate is filed
(§ 635 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2785) March 17, 2016

10. Last day for Secretary of the Commonwealth to certify names and residence of all candidates March 28, 2016
(30th day preceding the day fixed for the special election. § 636 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2786)
(Because March 27th falls on a Sunday, the date moves to the next business day, which is March 28th § 104 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2604.)
11. Last day to register to vote before the election March 28, 2016
(30 days before the election. § 1(b) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 Pa C.S.A. § 1326(b))
(Because March 27th falls on a Sunday, the date moves to the next business day, which is March 28th § 104 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 2604.)
12. Last day before the election on which official applications for civilian absentee ballots may be received by the county board of elections April 19, 2016
(Tuesday before election. § 1302.1 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. §3146.2a(a))
13. All regular civilian absentee ballots must be received by the county board of elections not later than 5:00 P.M. on this day to be counted April 22, 2016
(Friday before the election. § 1306 of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 3146.6(a))
14. Last day for county boards of elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots. May 3, 2016
(by 5:00 P.M. on the 7th day following a primary or election and must be voted no later than 11:59pm on April 25). § 3146.8(g)(1) & 25 Pa.C.S. § 3511(a)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- A. Political Parties file nomination certificates, nominating candidates in accordance with party rules.
- B. Independent candidates of political bodies file nomination papers, obtaining signatures equal to 2% of the largest vote cast for any elected officer in that district at the last preceding election or the number of signatures required on a nomination petition for a political party candidate, whichever is greater. Signers of such papers must be qualified, registered electors of the district. The number of signatures required on nomination papers to be filed by independent candidates of political bodies for the Special Election for the 9th Senatorial District to be held April 26, 2016 is 500. All nomination papers must be accompanied by a properly completed candidate's affidavit and a copy of the Statement of Financial Interests required to be filed with the State Ethics Commission. In addition, a

filing fee of \$100.00 must be submitted with each set of nomination papers and must be paid by certified check or money order payable to the 'Commonwealth of Pennsylvania'.

*Postmarks are acceptable as proof of timely filing when reports are postmarked by the U.S. Postal Service no later than the day before the filing deadline.
