[Ronald K. Rouse, Esquire, Board Counsel, stated the purpose of the special meeting is to vote on the adoption of the final rulemaking for regulation 16A-4211 regarding barber fees. He noted that the State Board of Barber Examiners has not increased fees since 2014 and is currently financially in the red and would be unable to support itself unless fees are increased.

Mr. Rouse submitted a copy of the preamble, annex, and the Regulatory Analysis Form (RAF) to all Board members for their review as part of the final rulemaking. He informed the Board that a vote adopting the regulation is required so he could schedule a meeting with the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC).

Mr. Rouse noted that the proposed rulemaking for regulation 16A-4211 was published in Volume 51 of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at pages 3342 to 3347 for review and comment on June 19, 2021, followed by a 30-day public comment period, during which time the Board received no public comment.

Mr. Rouse received four comments from IRRC regarding the proposed rulemaking for regulation 16A-4211 on August 18, 2021, which he addressed in the final rulemaking; in the preamble and the RAF.
