3 State Board of Crane Operators 1 July 27, 2022 2 * * * 3 [Pursuant to Section 708(a)(5) of the Sunshine Act, at 4 5 10:00 a.m. the Board entered into Executive Session with Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, 6 7 for the purpose of conducting quasi-judicial deliberations on a number of matters that are 8 currently pending before the Board and to receive the 9 10 advice of counsel. The Board returned to open session 11 at 10:30 a.m.] * * * 12 13 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State 14 Board of Crane Operators was held on Wednesday, July 15 27, 2022. Andrew S. Goulet, Chair, Professional Member, called the meeting to order at 10:31 a.m. 16 * * * 17 18 [Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, noted the meeting was being recorded, and those who 19 20 continued to participate were giving their consent to 21 be recorded. 22 Mr. Picarella also noted the Board met in 23 Executive Session prior to the Board meeting for the 24 purpose of conducting quasi-judicial deliberations and 25 to receive the advice of counsel.]

4 * * * 1 2 Roll Call/Introductions 3 [A roll call of Board members was taken by Ms. Li. 4 She also provided an introduction of attendees.] * * * 5 Approval of minutes of the May 25, 2022 meeting 6 7 MR. PICARELLA: 8 We will move to approval of minutes from 9 the last meeting. 10 Does anybody have any changes, 11 additions, or amendments to the minutes 12 from the meeting of May 25, 2022? I believe the Board would entertain 13 14 a motion to approve the meeting's minutes from May 25, 2022 as written. 15 Do I have such a motion? 16 17 MR. MITCHELL: 18 I'll make that motion to approve. 19 CHAIR GOULET: 20 I'll second that motion. 21 MR. PICARELLA: 2.2 We have a motion and a second. Any 23 further discussion? Ms. Li, would you 24 do a roll call? 25

5 Acting Commissioner Claggett, aye; Mr. 1 2 Goulet, aye; Mr. Kuncelman, aye; Mr. 3 Mauger, abstain; Mr. Mitchell, aye; Mr. Schmoyer, abstain. 4 5 [The motion carried. F. Allan Mauger and Brian 6 Schmoyer abstained from voting on the motion.] * * * 7 8 Report of Prosecutorial Division 9 [Matthew A. Anderson, Esquire, Board Prosecutor, noted 10 prosecution had nothing new to report.] * * * 11 Report of Board Counsel 12 13 [Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, 14 welcomed Steven Kuncelman as a new professional Board 15 member. 16 Steven Kuncelman provided a brief summary of his 17 professional background. Mr. Picarella referred to the memorandum from the 18 19 chairs of the House and Senate Professional Licensure 20 Committees regarding the passage of Act 41 of 2019 to 21 promulgate regulations regarding licensure by 22 endorsement for people not licensed in Pennsylvania 23 but may be licensed in other jurisdictions. 24 Mr. Picarella stated that Act 41 would streamline 25 the process and allow people to receive licensure in a

1 more efficient and quick manner to help bolster 2 workforce in Pennsylvania for all of the licensed 3 professions. He mentioned that two boards have fully 4 promulgated Act 41 licensure by endorsement.

5 Mr. Picarella noted the Board had published the 6 regulation as proposed and received comments from the 7 Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) and 8 the legislative committees. He informed Board members 9 that he has been working on drafting responses to 10 those and would bring those before the Board in the 11 future.

Mr. Picarella referred to the response of the commissioner's office explaining the boards are in the process and should have everything wrapped up in the near future. He reported that many other boards have had a lot of Act 41 Applications for licensure by endorsement but the Board of Crane Operators has not had any to date.

Mr. Picarella commented that their initial licensure requirements are pretty much the same as licensure by endorsement, but licensure by endorsement requires showing two years of experience in the profession and it might be easier to apply for licensure directly. He noted the application under this particular regulation will probably be limited to

somebody coming in from another country or maybe those
in the military.

3 Mr. Picarella notified Board members of a current scam affecting boards and informed everyone that the 4 5 Scam Alert is available on the Board's website. Нe 6 read the Bureau of Professional and Occupational 7 Affairs (BPOA) Scam Alert, where the BPOA has recently received reports that persons pretending to be from 8 one of the health-related boards are contacting 9 10 licensees by phone and mail about the status of their 11 licenses.

Mr. Picarella noted scammers are altering information on caller ID to appear to be from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and threatening license suspension for failure to act and falsely claiming involvement with federal agencies, such as the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

Mr. Picarella stated scammers are known to threaten license suspension for failure to provide personal information. He provided reminders from BPOA concerning contact and personal information for licensees.

24 Mr. Picarella noted licensees would never be 25 contacted by phone for payment. He reminded everyone

to not give personal or financial information over the 1 2 phone. He mentioned that those who are the subject of 3 an investigation or disciplinary action will receive 4 notice by certified mail and/or personal service and 5 are provided with a contact name and phone number. 6 Mr. Picarella informed everyone to contact their 7 local police department or the Pennsylvania State Police if they have been a victim of the scam.] 8 9 * * * 10 Report of Acting Commissioner 11 [Arion R. Claggett, Acting Commissioner, Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs, notified 12 13 everyone of in-person Board member training on October 14 24, 2022, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. in Harrisburg. Нe 15 mentioned that some of the topics include the role of Board counsel, prosecution, and some other areas 16 within the Bureau of Professional and Occupational 17 18 Affairs. He noted the training is mandatory for 19 public members but also encouraged professional 20 members to attend.] 21 * * * 22 Report of Board Chair - No Report 23 * * * 24 Report of Board Administrator 25 [Amanda Li, Board Administrator, announced this was

her last Board meeting and thanked everyone. 1 2 Mr. Picarella thanked Ms. Li for all of her assistance. 3 Chair Goulet also thanked Ms. Li for her 4 dedicated service to the Board.] 5 * * * 6 7 Miscellaneous 8 CHAIR PICARELLA: 9 The next item on the agenda would be 10 approving the Board meeting schedule for 2023. 11 12 We need to entertain a motion to 13 approve the schedule. MR. SCHMOYER: 14 15 I'll make a motion to approve the 16 schedule. 17 MR. KUNCELMAN: 18 Second. 19 MR.
