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3 State Board of Crane Operators 1 July 29, 2021 2 \* \* \* 3 [Pursuant to Section 708(a)(5) of the Sunshine Act, at 4 1 p.m. the Board entered into Executive Session with 5 6 Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, for 7 the purpose of conducting quasi-judicial deliberations on a number of matters that are currently pending 8 9 before the Board and to receive the advice of counsel. 10 The Board returned to open session at 2 p.m.] \* \* \* 11 Meeting Instructions 12 13 [Amanda Li, Board Administrator, provided instructions to be followed during the virtual meeting.] 14 \* \* \* 15 16 [Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, 17 noted the meeting was being recorded, and those who 18 continued to participate were giving their consent to 19 be recorded. 20 Mr. Picarella also noted the Board met in 21 Executive Session prior to the Board meeting for the 22 purpose of conducting quasi-judicial deliberations and 23 to receive the advice of counsel.] \* \* \* 24 25 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State

Board of Crane Operators was held on Thursday, July 1 2 29, 2021. Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board 3 Counsel, called the meeting to order at 2 p.m.] \* \* \* 4 5 Roll Call/Introductions 6 [A roll call of Board members was taken by Ms. Li. 7 She also provided the introduction of attendees.] \* \* \* 8 9 [Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel, 10 informed everyone that today was a special meeting and would be abbreviated. He noted they had to properly 11 sunshine the current meeting after the date of the 12 13 original meeting was changed. He mentioned that there 14 would be a reduced agenda with a lot of the matters 15 from the original agenda moved to the next agenda.] \* \* \* 16 17 MR. PICARELLA: 18 At this point, since we do not currently 19 have a Board chair, I would ask for any 20 nominations for Board chair? 21 MR. SCHMOYER: I'll make a motion we nominate Buddy 22 23 Mauger for the chair. 24 COMMISSIONER JOHNSON: 25 Second.

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5 1 MR. PICARELLA: 2 We have a motion and a second. Any 3 discussion? Before we take the vote, I 4 will ask Mr. Mauger if he would accept 5 the nomination. 6 MR. MAUGER: 7 Yes, sir, I'll accept the nomination. 8 MR. PICARELLA: 9 With that, I would ask for a roll call 10 vote as to the election of Mr. Mauger as 11 the Board chair. 12 13 Commissioner Johnson, aye; Mr. Buddy 14 Mauger, aye; Mr. Daniel Mitchell, aye; 15 Mr. Brian Schmoyer, aye. MR. PICARELLA: 16 With that, I believe the election is 17 18 unanimous. Mr. Mauger, congratulations. 19 [The motion carried unanimously] \* \* \* 20 21 MR. MAUGER ASSUMED THE CHAIR \* \* \* 22 23 Report of Prosecutorial Division - No Report \* \* \* 24 25 Report of Board Counsel - Regulations

[Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Senior Board Counsel,
 noted agenda items 3 and 4 were discussed during
 Executive Session.

Mr. Picarella addressed 16A-7103 regarding the schedule of civil penalties that was presented to the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) at their June 17, 2021 meeting. He stated IRRC issued an order on July 8, 2021, denying that regulation. He noted the Board now has 40 days to resubmit it to IRRC.

Mr. Picarella informed the Board that IRRC denied the regulation for two reasons because certain sections lacked clarity, and IRRC did not believe the regulation, as presented, would adequately protect public health, safety, and welfare.

Mr. Picarella addressed the clarity issue, where IRRC believed that the sections dealing with operating a crane without a license or employing a licensed person to operate a crane should had been limited to situations where there was no incident involving bodily harm or significant property damage.

Mr. Picarella stated IRRC suggested a set dollar amount on any incident involving property damage or bodily harm and limit the use or application of the citation only if that limit has not been reached. He

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explained that in order to avoid setting a number that 1 2 may cause litigation issues, he amended those sections 3 to have the qualifying language added provided that no bodily injury or property damage was involved that 4 5 applies to the two sections for operating unlicensed 6 or operating while lapsed and also the section 7 regarding employing a person who is not properly licensed to operate a crane. 8

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Mr. Picarella addressed IRRC's comments regarding 9 10 public health and safety, where IRRC questioned why 11 the Commissioner and the Board did not include a 12 violation of the Act and regulations that requires a crane operator to maintain certification and/or submit 13 14 evidence of recertification during the biennial 15 licensing period in the schedule of civil penalties. 16 He noted IRRC believed that including the violation in 17 the schedule of civil penalties is in the best 18 interest of public health and safety.

Mr. Picarella noted he amended the annex to include citation authority for a violation of the act at section § 2400.502(b) and the regulations at 49 Pa. Code § 6.32(a)(2) to read, "failing to maintain certification or submit evidence or renewal certification before the expiration date of the certification."

Mr. Picarella noted he also set the penalty for a 1 2 first offense under the section at a \$1,000 fine and 3 any subsequent offenses would be subject to formal 4 prosecution in the schedule. He also made changes to 5 the preamble and Regulatory Analysis Form to reflect 6 those changes.] 7 MR. PICARELLA: 8 I believe the Board would entertain a 9 motion to adopt the changes to the 10 annex, preamble, and Regulatory Analysis 11 Form as presented and direct me to 12 promulgate the regulation as final 13 rulemaking. Do I have such a motion? 14 15 CHAIR MAUGER: 16 I make a motion that we approve them as 17 read. 18 COMMISSIONER JOHNSON: 19 Second. 20 MR. PICARELLA: 21 We have a motion and a second. Roll 2.2 call vote. 23 24 Commissioner Johnson, aye; Mr. Mauger, 25 yes; Mr. Mitchell, aye; Mr. Schmoyer,

1 aye. 2 [The motion carried unanimously] \* \* \* 3 4 Report of Commissioner 5 [K. Kalonji Johnson, Commissioner, Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs, apprised Board 6 7 members that beginning October 1, 2021, the pre-COVID physical presence requirement in the practice act 8 9 would take precedence and in-person meetings would 10 resume unless the general assembly decides to extend 11 those waivers or elects to incorporate some of the protocols that were in place during COVID into the 12 13 existing statutes. Commissioner Johnson stated individuals would be 14 15 participating virtually at the next meeting, and he 16 should have additional information at that time about 17 subsequent meetings. 18 Commissioner Johnson addressed physical travel requests, noting physical travel is accepted up to the 19 20 pre-COVID limit of two members with the rest of the 21 Board having the option of attending virtually, which

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22 he recommended for public health and safety. He 23 encouraged everyone to submit travel requests as soon 24 as possible so any concerns can be addressed at the 25 higher administrative level.]
