Continuing Education Credits for Charitable
Volunteerism was previously discussed. He noted that
on November 3 of 2022, Act 159 of 2022 was signed in
by the Governor and will take effect within 60 days,

Mr. Rouse explained that Act 159 allows up to three hours of volunteer work to be counted towards continuing educational credits for dentists, dental hygienists, expanded function dental assistants who volunteer time by practicing at a clinic or health center or at an event or program offered by a charitable entity.

He further explained that "clinic, health center

1 or charitable entity would only include those places

- 2 for which the licensee or certificate holder is
- 3 providing services at no cost to patients and
- 4 | "volunteer services" would only include time spent in
- 5 | the actual delivery of oral healthcare or in direct
- 6 support of oral healthcare.

- 10 the fact that charitable volunteerism is also allowed

Ms. Fowler indicated Dr. Funari and Dr. Sullivan are continuing research on anesthesia including draft revisions to the preamble in the annex forwarded to Board Counsel. Botox and dermal fillers are also being researched by Dr. Sullivan and Dr. Funari.

Dr. Mountain provided a really helpful presentation regarding the mobile vans and identified a number of issues that were needed to be addressed. Topics discussed included lack of referral for follow-up, need for consumer awareness, transfer of records.

General revisions included the need to clarify the language regarding the authorized testing agencies to include both predecessor and successor names of those agencies. Revision to require a
