Chair Johnson asked what the timeline would be based on past experience.

Mr. McMurry explained that the Commission opens the program one meeting and works between meetings, where there hopefully could be a vote at the next meeting. He noted it depends on responses and is flexible and that there is no problem pushing it until January or February if everything is not ready by the November meeting. He mentioned that the program takes between three to four years.

Mr. Sullivan commented that there was a timeline where the matter must be advertised prior to the applications, noting the sooner the matter was advertised, the sooner the process could move
