6 Appointment - Holy Family University Proposal for a
7 Family/Individual Across the Lifespan CRNP
8 Program

9 [Cynthia A. Russell, Ph.D., RN, FAAN, PCC, NBC-HWC,
10 Dean and Professor, Holy Family University School of
11 Nursing and Allied Health Professions; Mary Frances
12 Suter, DNP, RN, CRNP, AG-ACNP, GNP-BC, AACCC, NEA-BC
13 Director, Doctor of Nursing Practice Program/Assistant
14 Professor, Holy Family University School of Nursing
15 and Allied Health Professions; Kristin Moroski, CPA,
16 CGMA, Senior Finance Analyst, Holy Family University
17 School of Nursing and Allied Health Professions; and
18 Julia Scherpenberg, CRNP, Director of Health Services,
19 Holy Family University School of Nursing and Allied
20 Health Professions, presented before the Board to
21 review their proposal for a Family/Individual Across
22 the Lifespan CRNP Program.

23 Dr. Russell provided a summary of the Holy Family
24 University's background and history. She stated Holy
25 Family University intends to offer two points of

1 entry, including post baccalaureate to DNP (BSN-DNP)
2 and post Master of Science in nursing to DNP (MS-FNP-
3 DNP), both with eligibility for CRNP certification.

4 Dr. Russell reviewed the program curriculum
5 including course descriptions. She stated the 674
6 hours for the Family/Individual Across the Lifespan
7 CRNP specialty exceeds the minimum of 500 clinical
8 hours in order to offer an opportunity to provide care
9 to multiple age groups in multiple peer settings.

10 Dr. Russell discussed a market analysis that was
11 completed for regional DNP and FNP programs that also
12 provided the context for establishing the per credit
13 cost of the program. Criteria for determining the
14 number of students admitted to the program and
15 criteria on behalf of the University to meet the
16 financial needs of the program were also noted.

17 Admission requirements, learning outcomes, and a
18 systematic evaluation plan for the CRNP program were
19 reviewed by Dr. Russell as well as criteria to be
20 utilized by both students and faculty during the
21 evaluation process.

22 Dr. Russell explained that a clinical placement
23 coordinator would be hired in January of 2019 to
24 assist students with clinical placements. She noted
25 that supervision of all students would be performed by

1 the CRNP faculty. She reviewed the NPST student
2 tracking system for all FNP students.

3 Chairperson Kmetz noted the Board would
4 deliberate on Holy Family University's proposal during
5 Executive Session.]

8 [Judith Pachter Schulder, Esquire, Board Counsel,
9 noted that the Governor's Policy Office requested
10 that, in addition to the neighboring states, a review
11 of fees be conducted for the entire region for the fee

14 education program fees will be conducted as well.
