6 Report of Board Members

7 [Catherine S. Spayd, Ph.D., Vice Chair, reviewed her
8 topic of discussion for the luncheon regarding the
9 Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology
10 (EPPP) Part 2. She stated the Association of State
11 and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB) clarified
12 that this was a revision of the current exam.

13 Dr. Spayd noted EPPP Part 1 and Part 2. ASPPB
14 indicated there would be no need for a change to the
15 Board's regulations. She confirmed the Board's
16 support for the utilization of Part 2.]

17 ***

18 FYI Items

19 [Katherine Bradley, Ph.D., Secretary, noted the May
20 2018 ASPPB Board of Directors letter.

21 Chairman DonGiovanni mentioned his attendance at
22 the most recent meeting, noting Mariann Brunetti-
23 Atwell, Psy.D., as the new Chief Executive Officer of
24 ASPPB.

25 Chairman DonGiovanni commented on Part 2, noting

1 its availability via computer with vignettes and
2 avatars.

3 Dr. Bradley explained EPPP Part 1 as a test of
4 the knowledge of psychology, and EPPP Part 2 as a test
5 of competency in applying knowledge in clinical
6 situations.

7 Chairman DonGiovanni noted that the test will
8 cost \$600, in addition to the current \$600.

9 Dr. Spayd stated ASPPB will not enter into a
10 contract with any state that does not subscribe to
11 both parts.

12 Dr. Small added the Board of Directors of ASPPB
13 made this decision on their own and did not consult
14 the membership. Dr. Small explained ASPPB propagated
15 a change in its bylaws that allows the Board of
16 Trustees to make decisions on behalf of the
17 jurisdictions without their vote.

18 Dr. Small reviewed the item development in 2018,
19 beta testing in 2019, and the projected roll out in
20 January 2020.

21 Mr. Narvol noted the current regulation for state
22 applicants to obtain a passing score on the EPPP and
23 the Pennsylvania Psychology Law Examination.

24 Dr. Spayd suggested language clarifying the use
25 of EPPP for reasons of interjurisdictional equality

1 and to avoid the cost of developing a valid and
2 reliable alternative.]

3 ***

4 Discussion Item - ASPPB/National Register Joint
5 Designation

6 [Chairman DonGiovanni discussed the ASPPB/National
7 Register Joint Designation Project ending on September
8 30, 2018, noting the need to review older
9 applications.]

10 ***

12 [Chairman DonGiovanni noted the tentative 2019 Board
13 meetings dates.]


