16 Matters for Deliberation

17 [Dana Wucinski, Esquire, Board Counsel, noted matters  
18 for deliberation during Executive Session as well as  
19 two scheduled hearings.]

20 \*\*\*

21 Report of Commissioner

22 [Ian J. Harlow, Commissioner of Professional and  
23 Occupational Affairs, updated the Board regarding  
24 placeholders on the executive nominations calendar.  
25 There have been no actual appointments.]

1           Commissioner Harlow noted the PALS project as on  
2 budget at \$2.5 million with recently authorized  
3 additional change orders still within budget.

4           Commissioner Harlow informed the Board of the  
5 resignation of Secretary Pedro Cortez. Robert Torres  
6 will be serving as Acting Secretary of the  
7 Commonwealth. He further stated Governor Wolf will be  
8 issuing an Executive Order directing the Commissioner  
9 to conduct an assessment of this Board in comparison  
10 to other states.

11           Commissioner Harlow stated the report as designed  
12 will determine each professional license type issued  
13 by a Board or Commission, including the training  
14 requirements, licensing, registration, renewal fees,  
15 continuing education requirements and additional  
16 requirements as stipulated by the Practice Act or  
17 regulations for that Board. A one-for-one comparison  
18 will then be conducted with every state to assess each  
19 State Board within its profession.

20           The Commissioner explained the Executive Order  
21 allows for the appointment of a Commission that would  
22 consist of a representative from the Governor's  
23 Office, a representative from the Policy Office of the  
24 Department of State, two individuals from the  
25 business-related boards and two individuals from the

1 health-related boards, a consumer protection rep from  
2 the Office of Attorney General, one Democrat and one  
3 Republican from the Senate Oversight Committee and the  
4 House Oversight Committee. Public members will also  
5 participate.

6 Commissioner Harlow asked for nominations from  
7 Chairs and peers to vote for two people from the  
8 business side and two people from the health side to  
9 represent the committee. The data collection will be  
10 presented in a final report form within 180 days.

11 Each Board will then decide whether or not to  
12 make revisions to statutes, as well as regulatory and  
13 policy changes, based on the factual data.

14 Commissioner Harlow stated state-by-state  
15 statistical data will be collected, including impact  
16 of criminal histories on licensure, as well as  
17 assessing the statistics on approval and denials,  
18 interstate compacts in relation to a particular  
19 profession, as well as disciplinary actions taken by  
20 boards.

21 Commissioner Harlow stated the Executive Order  
22 report will capture the demographic information of all  
23 Board members and our licensing community. The data  
24 will be used to identify Board members from the  
25 community including race, ethnicity, gender, and

1 regional statistics. The Board will receive a copy of  
2 the press release once Governor Wolf signs the  
3 Executive Order.

4 Chair Matta offered the Board's services during  
5 this process. It was stated the Association of Social  
6 Work Boards (ASWB) may also be helpful in this  
7 matter.]

14 Qualifications for Supervisors  
15 [Dr. Joy E. Corby, LMFT, addressed qualifications for  
16 approved clinical supervisors. She indicated that  
17 Marriage and Family Therapy is the only profession  
18 that has its own supervisor regulations and  
19 certifications. She referred Board members to a  
20 handout for further discussion regarding proposed  
21 changes of qualifications for supervisors and  
22 suggested that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania adopt  
23 the same.

24 Dr. Corby reported on attending the recent  
25 Association of Marriage & Family Therapy Regulatory



1 Boards (AMFTRB) meeting. She addressed the adequacy  
2 of regulations and certifications and asked the Board  
3 to consider adopting the language.

4 Dr. Kraus urged the Board to take a careful look  
5 at the national performance of the Approved Clinical  
6 Supervisor (ACS) credential. He noted the difficulty  
7 in finding people to supervise would be challenged by  
8 raising that bar.

9 Dr. Corby commented that certain states will not  
10 need to adopt this regulation based on their own  
11 regulations.

12 Dr. Corby stated a key point noted at the meeting  
13 is that all states have regulatory boards whose  
14 standards are adequate "so why allow equivalency to  
15 say that we're better than them."

16 Dr. Kraus discussed adequacy versus equivalency  
17 and mentioned finding an adequate level for  
18 supervisors just below the ACS credential.

19 Chair Matta suggested devising a committee with  
20 one individual from each profession to be a  
21 representative. It was suggested that the committee  
22 look at adequacy for portability as well. Dr. Kraus,  
23 Dr. Corby, and Ms. Cardone volunteered for the  
24 committee. It was also suggested that supervisory and  
25 mobility issues be kept separate for the committee.

1           Due to conflict, Dr. Kraus offered to volunteer  
2 for the supervisory issue only. Whether or not  
3 committee discussion would need to be public session  
4 will be ascertained.]

10 ASWB Member Board Contributions to Mobility Strategy  
11 [Renee J. Cardone, MSW, LCSW, Vice Chairperson,  
12 informed the Board that she will be attending the  
13 ASWB Delegate Assembly meeting in Atlanta. Ms.  
14 Cardone noted ASWB is promoting mobility across states  
15 and requesting endorsement from members of ASWB. Ms.  
16 Cardone stated that ASWB is not asking states to  
17 standardize but wants more mobility across states to  
18 harmonize licensure eligibility criteria. She  
19 indicated that ASWB will create a secure databank in  
20 order to locate all information in one place.

21           Ms. Cardone reviewed the ASWB Member Board  
22 Contributions to Mobility Strategy document. She  
23 mentioned identifying barriers that would prohibit  
24 participation in the ASWB mobility strategy and  
25 minimum essential adequacy.

1 Ms. Cardone will research whether information is  
2 voluntary and if there are registry fees. She will  
3 provide additional information to the Board at a  
4 future meeting.

5 Ms. Cardone informed the Board that some  
6 hospitals are designating their social workers as  
7 clinical social workers. Ms. Cardone recommended  
8 reporting it to investigations and talking to people  
9 personally.]
