Chair Goldman informed Board members that the call for papers for the Pennsylvania Speech-Language-Hearing Association Convention April 12-15, 2023, at Valley Forge Casino Resort in King of Prussia, PA, has been announced. She noted the need to authorize representation at the December meeting, and she would be submitting an update presentation on behalf of the Board.
