2 [Amy S. Goldman, MS, CCC-SLP, Chair, welcomed Dana
3 Wucinski to the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language
4 Pathology and Audiology.

5 Chair Goldman requested information regarding the
6 two public member vacancies and encouraged anyone who
7 is not a professional member to apply if they have
8 the qualifications.

9 Ms. Wucinski had not received any emails
10 verifying any movement.

11 Dr. Murphy stated there were no new names for
12 public members for the Board when he checked the
13 listing of appointments to be approved through the
14 Pennsylvania Senate.

15 Chair Goldman requested an update on issues
16 regarding the interstate compact. She noted that one
17 of the stumbling blocks to the implementation of
18 multiple compacts is the issue regarding
19 fingerprinting.

20 Ms. Wucinski stated the fingerprinting issue is
21 holding up a lot of compacts. She noted there has
22 been communication with the state police with no
23 resolution.

24 Chair Goldman requested an update concerning
25 telepractice regulations, especially in light of the

1 expiration of waivers regarding telepractice. She
2 noted the preference a while back was to address
3 telemedicine and telerehabilitation broadly rather
4 than discipline by discipline.

5 Ms. Wucinski noted not seeing the telehealth bill
6 for a while but informed Board members that she would
7 place any bill affecting the Board on the agenda.
8 She commented that Marc Farrell would be posting new
9 telemedicine FAQs in chat for current information on
10 the existing regulation.

11 Chair Goldman informed Board members that the
12 call for papers for the Pennsylvania Speech-Language-
13 Hearing Association Convention April 12-15, 2023, at
14 Valley Forge Casino Resort in King of Prussia, PA,
15 has been announced. She noted the need to authorize
16 representation at the December meeting, and she would
17 be submitting an update presentation on behalf of the
18 Board.
