Mr. Fritz explained that a participation fee in the Board of Vehicles Act is meant to be part of the package of information to be sent to the Board as proof that the participate took part in a show in Pennsylvania, which is the reason to keep participation fee separate from registration fee.

Mr. Fritz recommended keeping the regulation as is and informing IRRC of the Board's interpretation of participation until another regulation could be drafted to clarify and define participation.

Mr. Fritz addressed IRRC's other issue regarding a conflict with existing regulations, where IRRC suggested a separate regulation at some point to make sure everything matches between Act 90 and what the Board proposed with the RV fee. He attached Act 90, which is what evolved as far as all the additions to the act related to RV dealers, for the Board's review.]
