Laura Mitchell, t/d/b/a L and L Salon, license no. CB115577 of Mt. Pocono, Monroe County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$750 for practicing cosmetology in a grossly incompetent manner. (08/14/09)

Alicia Lynn Kofke, license no. RN567928 of Shillington, Berks County, is indefinitely suspended for no less than three years, with suspension immediately stayed in favor of no less than three years of probation. This is because she is unable to practice the profession with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of mental or physical illness or condition or physiological or psychological dependence upon alcohol, hallucinogenic or narcotic drugs or other drugs, which tend to impair judgment or coordination. In addition, she has violated a lawful disciplinary order of the board and has pled guilty to a felony under the Drug Act. (10/23/09)
