PN261515L of Lititz, Lancaster County, had her nursing license suspended for no less than three years, retroactive to Sept. 9, 2008, based on findings that she is unable to practice nursing with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of addiction to alcohol or other drugs which tend to impair judgment or coordination.
