## **PA Board of Accountancy**

### **Allegheny County**

AF000379L, of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, was ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$3,500 and costs of investigation of \$375.60 because it practiced public accounting on a lapsed license, by holding itself out as a certified public accounting firm, and by holding its agents, servants, employees, and/or partners out as a certified public accountants.
