Betty Jean Parks-Griffin, notary commission no. 1125710, of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, permanently and voluntarily surrendered her notary commission because she failed to know through personal knowledge or have satisfactory evidence that the person appearing before her was the party who executed the document; failed to maintain an accurate notary register; failed to be familiar with the duties and responsibilities of a notary public by failing to include the essential notarization language on a letter, failing to maintain an accurate notary register, and failing to obtain personal appearance; and failed to be of good character, integrity, and ability by failing to require personal appearance, failing to maintain an accurate notary register, and failing to include the essential notarization language on a letter.
