RADER: 20 So moved. MR. HOSTETTER: 21 22 Second. 23 CHAIRMAN RENTZEL: 24 Any discussion? No corrections. All 25 those in favor of accepting the minutes,

Kalonji Johnson, Acting Commissioner, outlined the 17 new security and hours for the Penn Center Complex.] \* \* \* 18 19 Report of Board Administrator 20 [Terrie Kocher, Board Administrator, discussed Board 21 member attendance at the PAA conference scheduled for 22 January 7 - 10, 2020. 23 Chairman Rentzel discussed changing the Board's 24 January meeting date. Ms. Kocher will check the 25 calendar for available dates.]

SUTER: 25

6 The Board was in Executive Session. 1 The 2 purpose of the Executive Session was to 3 discuss Items 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 on the 4 Board agenda. As a result of the 5 Executive Session, I understand the Board will entertain some motions. 6 7 The first motion is for Item No. 2 8 on the agenda. This is an application 9 for an auctioneer license by Tumbelekis. 10 I understand that the motion that the Board will entertain is for a 11 12 provisional denial of this application. All those in favor, 14 give their consent by saying aye. 15 Opposed? 16 [The motion carried unanimously.] \* \* \* 17 18 Report of Board Counsel (Continued) 19 [Kenneth J. Suter, Esquire, Board Counsel, discussed 20 reciprocity and the difficulties with comparing one 21 jurisdiction's provisions for auctioneers with 22 another. He specifically cited the three provisions 23 for reciprocity in Section 12 of the Act. 24 Mr. Suter noted an increased frequency of 25 applications for reciprocity being received by the

Board. He stressed the importance of the Board being
consistent in its determinations on these
applications.

4 Chairman Rentzel stated the Board follows the 5 standards as in Section 12 (a)(3) in its 6 determinations on reciprocity, specifically with 7 regard to time, experience, a license, and an 8 examination comparable to Pennsylvania. Mr. Hostetter 9 reiterated the need to confirm the four areas as 10 outlined by the Chairman.

11 Mr. Suter noted an amendment to the Act in 2016. 12 He recognized prior reciprocal agreements with other states. The current Act requires the Board to analyze 13 14 the applications prior to its determination. Mr. 15 Suter stated the Board needed to set guidelines by 16 which it will make its determinations in the future. 17 Mr. Rader noted that since 2016 the Board has 18 discussed each application as a group in order to make 19 its determination.] 20 \* \* \* 21 [Mr. Suter stated Item No. 7 on the agenda, Bauer 22 Litigation Update, was discussed in Executive

23 Session.]
