Chairman Christopher explained a report will be issued by license type, state, and region. He provided a summary of the data elements for each license type. The Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs (BPOA) partnered with St. Francis University for analysis. He stated Dr. Timmons of St. Francis University and his team from the Knee Center for the Study of Occupational Regulation (CSOR) are performing the bulk of the work in coordination with the BPOA staff.

Chairman Christopher added that the work will focus mainly on analysis of the current licensing standards within the Northeast quadrant of the United States. Chairman Christopher stated the Advisory Committee is merely guiding and shaping the data collection but will also be responsible for compiling the final report for the Governor. The report will

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also be provided to stakeholders, licensing Boards,
and other interested parties to review the data and
present recommendations.
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Chairman Christopher will continue to update the Board on the progress of this report and its impact on the Boards and licenses.

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Relating to the legislative initiative, I wanted to restate or revisit some of the items, which we briefly discussed in Executive Session.

There was discussion of the terms to be added to the new subsection that we proposed as to the barber statute, in particular to specify that it must be used at a licensed barbershop employing licensed barbers.

The Board also wanted to make it clear that it was not only a vertical emblem but any kind of emblem, so we were removing vertical from the proposed new text. The Board wanted to make clear that the restrictions apply to any image or representation of the pole, not just a physical pole and wanted to add the power to order removal of a pole,

which violates the proposed section in addition to the prohibition on its use to make clear of that power.

As it relates to the legislative initiative process, we discussed the basis that we would add, the reasoning behind this, the pole being the most identifiable emblem of profession, clearly communicate the location of our rank services, wants to ensure the public knows that locations using the symbol are fully licensed to offer barbering services.

We want to include in that, the harm to the customer of potentially being misled as to the nature of the services being offered and noting also the potential for unfair competition of nonlicensed shops displaying the pole.
