She requested that the Board review the USPAP standards for the next board meeting so that professional board member may provide input on those provisions. Board Counsel stated that while she was temporarily assigned to another agency, the Board discussed a proposal to reduce the continuing education (CE) requirements for certified evaluators.

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The Board discussed its rationale for not wanting to reduce the number of CE hours for evaluators. The Board agreed that sending an exposure draft with the suggested decreased hours was appropriate so that the Board can receive input from interested parties.

Steve Howe, Assessors' Association of Pennsylvania (AAP), discussed the 16A-7018 Annex. He noted a misunderstanding between the terms real estate appraisal versus real property appraisal. Mr. Howe suggested updating the references to USPAP. He also expressed a concern related to reducing CE hours from 28 to 20.
