Ms. Wolfgang noted the proposed federal rule that 1 would increase the federal threshold level. 2. 3 Appraisals will not be required for federal commercial 4 real estate transactions from \$250,000 to \$400,000. 5 She will add that proposed rule to the next agenda for the Board's review. Ms. Wolfgang indicated that 6 7 inquires have been received regarding whether or not appraisals have to follow the Uniform Standards of 8 Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) in threshold 9 10 type of cases. 11 She referred Board members to information regarding the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) challenge 12

regarding the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) challenge of the Louisiana Real Estate Appraiser Board's customary and reasonable fees for appraisal services.

Ms. Wolfgang referred Board members to the 2017
Association of Appraiser Regulatory Officials (AARO)
Newsletter, 2016 Appraisal Subcommittee (ASC) Annual
Report, listing of stakeholders, and Senate Bill 832
for further review. She noted House Bill 1361, which
