Becker, Professional Member, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. 8 He 9 stated the meeting was being recorded and voluntary 10 participation constitutes consent to be recorded. * * * 11 12 CHAIR BECKER: Do I have a motion to start the meeting? 13 MR. HAULMAN: 14 15 I'll make a motion to start the meeting. ACTING COMMISSIONER JOHNSON: 16 17 I'll second. CHAIR BECKER: 18 All in favor? Opposed? 19 20 [The motion carried unanimously.] 21 * * * 2.2 Introductions 23 [Chair Becker requested the introduction of Board 24 members, Bureau Personnel, and audience members.] * * * 25

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Approval of Minutes 1 2 [Approval of Minutes of the January 22, 2020 meeting. CHAIR BECKER: 3 4 Do I have a motion to approve the 5 Minutes? 6 MR. Becker, Professional Member, Chair, exited 16 the meeting at 9:07 a.m. for recusal purposes.] * * * 17 18 Report of Prosecutorial Division 19 [Colby Widdowson, Esquire, Board Prosecution Liaison, 20 presented a Consent Agreement for File No. 18-71-21 011416.1 * * * 22 23 [Michael A. Becker, Professional Member, Chair, re-24 entered the meeting at 9:10 a.m.] 25 Report of Board Counsel

[Dean F. Picarella, Esquire, Board Counsel, noted 1 2 items for discussion in Executive Session. 1 * * * 3 4 Act 41 Regulations 5 [Mr. Picarella discussed the Act 41 Regulation, 6 Licensure by Endorsement. He explained the Act allows 7 individuals from other jurisdictions and countries access to licensure in Pennsylvania. Mr. Picarella 8 noted all of the Boards are promulgating the 9 regulation. He adapted the regulations of this Board. 10 11 He noted the regulation needed the Board's 12 review. If the amended regulation met the Board's 13 approval, it would be sent out as an exposure draft 14 for stakeholders for comment. The main items of 15 concern for the Board were whether the applicant was in good standing in another jurisdiction and that the 16 17 licensure requirements in the other jurisdiction were 18 substantially equivalent to Pennsylvania. 19 Ways of demonstrating competence were noted, 20 including continuing education requirements, which 21 this Board does not have, and to prove competency by 22 actively engaging in the profession for two of the 23 past five years. He discussed the terms of a 24 provisional license for those individuals who do not 25 technically meet all of the requirements.

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Mr. Picarella requested a motion to adopt the Act 1 2 41 Annex as stated which would then be sent out as an 3 exposure draft for comment. 4 Acting Commissioner Johnson noted this would 5 ensure that the Board is providing the greatest 6 opportunity for qualified professionals to come to 7 PA.] 8 MR. PICARELLA: 9 The Board would entertain a motion to 10 adopt Annex Act 41 as on the agenda at 11 Item No. 3 and to direct that the Annex 12 be sent out for exposure draft. 13 CHAIR BECKER: 14 Do I have a motion for Act 41 regulations 15 to be approved? 16 MR. GOULET: 17 I'd like to make that motion for Act 41 18 regulations to be approved. 19 ACTING COMMISSIONER JOHNSON: 20 Second. 21 CHAIR BECKER: 2.2 All in favor? Any opposed? 23 [The motion passed unanimously.] * * * 24 25 Miscellaneous

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1 [Mr. Picarella noted, due to coronavirus issues and 2 the ability of certain members of professions to 3 conform with certain regulatory and statutory issues 4 of licensure, the Commonwealth has been waiving some 5 requirements in the regulations.

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6 He commented, with this Board, one issue might be 7 recertification for licensure which does not always 8 coincide with the renewal period. He indicated that steps had been taken to waive parts of the regulation 9 10 under the Act, 501(f) and 502(b) and 49 Pa. Code, 11 Section 6.12 and 49 Pa. Code, Section 6.23(2) until 30 days after the emergency declaration is lifted.] 12 * * * 13 14 Report of Acting Commissioner 15 [K. Kalonji Johnson, Acting Commissioner, Bureau of 16 Professional and Occupational Affairs, thanked Board 17 members for their flexibility and commitment. Нe 18 stated virtual meetings would be the normal for a 19 little while.] 20 * * * 21 Report of Board Chair - No Report * * * 22 23 Report of Board Administrator - No Report * * * 24 25 [Acting Commissioner Johnson noted the presence of

Marc Farrell and Andrew LaFratte from the Department 1 2 of State Policy Office at the meeting. 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10 Commonwealth.]
