3 \* \* \* 1 2 State Board of Crane Operators 3 July 24, 2019 \* \* \* 4 5 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State Board 6 of Crane Operators was held on Wednesday, July 24, 2019. 7 \* \* \* 8 Official Call to Order 9 10 [Daniel R. Haulman, President, Professional Member, 11 called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A roll call 12 was taken.] \* \* \* 13 14 Introduction of Board Members, Board Staff, and 15 Audience 16 [President Haulman requested the introduction of Board 17 members, staff, and audience in attendance.] \* \* \* 18 Approval of Minutes of May 22, 2019 meeting. 19 20 PRESIDENT HAULMAN: At this time, I'd like to review the 21 Minutes from the last Board meeting. 22 Are 23 there any corrections that need to be 24 made? 25 MR. BECKER:

4 I saw no corrections. I make a motion to 1 2 accept the Minutes from the last meeting. 3 MR. MAUGER: I'll second that motion. 4 PRESIDENT HAULMAN: 5 All in favor? 6 7 [The motion carried unanimously.] \* \* \* 8 Report of Prosecutorial Division 9 10 Report of Deputy Chief Counsel Carolyn DeLaurentis [Carolyn A. DeLaurentis, Esquire, Deputy Chief 11 12 Counsel, Prosecution Division, introduced herself and 13 provided a brief summary of her professional 14 background. Ms. DeLaurentis reviewed information for the 15 16 State Board of Crane Operators for FY 2018-2019, 17 noting that 60 cases were opened with 48 open files as 18 of July 1, 2019. She also provided information 19 regarding enforcement statistics. 20 Ms. DeLaurentis noted six warning letters were sent. There were seven cases that resulted in fines, 21 22 one case resulted in a reprimand, and four cases 23 resulted in probation. She reviewed the process for 24 an immediate temporary suspension for an immediate 25 danger to the health and safety of the public. For FY

1 2018-2019, 69 immediate temporary suspensions were
2 completed.

There were 11,359 open cases for the whole prosecution division as of July 1, 2019. She reviewed the last fiscal year, noting that 14,030 cases were opened, which was up from 12,604 the prior fiscal year. She noted that 13,270 cases were closed the last fiscal year.

9 Ms. DeLaurentis discussed the Office of General 10 Counsel's Mediation Program, which is free of charge. 11 She stated the consent agreements will reflect whether 12 the case was resolved through mediation.

13 Ms. DeLaurentis addressed the Pennsylvania 14 Justice Network (JNET), where the prosecution division 15 receives an alert when licensees from all of the 16 Boards and Commissions are charged with a crime. 17 William C. Fritz, Esquire, Board Counsel, 18 provided an additional explanation of the mediation 19 program.] 20 \* \* \* [Colby Widdowson, Esquire, Board Prosecution Liaison, 21 22 presented Consent Agreements for File No. 19-71-23 002582.1 \* \* \* 2.4 25 Report of Board Counsel

[William C. Fritz, Esquire, Board Counsel, noted 1 matters for discussion during Executive Session. 2 3 Mr. Fritz stated Act 41 - House Bill 1172, Licensure by Endorsement, recently passed. 4 Нe explained the bill provides for the expediting of 5 licensure in the Commonwealth for individuals licensed 6 7 in another state or reciprocity. The Board will have to draft regulatory changes to enact the bill.] 8 9 \* \* \* 10 Regulatory Process Presentation [Cynthia Montgomery, Esquire, Deputy Chief Counsel, 11 introduced herself and provided a brief summary of her 12 13 professional background. 14 Ms. Montgomery detailed the following eight steps 15 in the regulatory process: Drafting of the proposed regulation; Pre-publication review and public 16 17 comments; Comment period for Independent Regulatory 18 Review Commission (IRRC) and Committees; the Board's 19 review and drafting of revisions; Final-form version 20 of the regulation and response; Review period by the 21 Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) and 22 Committees; the Office of Attorney General review; and the Final Publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. 23 24 Ms. Montgomery reviewed the statutory authority of 25 the Board. She also discussed the Board's commitment

1 under Section 204 of the Commonwealth Documents Law to 2 omit the notice of proposed rulemaking under very 3 limited circumstances.

Ms. Montgomery explained the Latin phrase "sine 4 die", meaning "without day", as it refers to the final 5 adjournment of a two-year legislative session in 6 7 Pennsylvania. Agencies may not deliver final regulations to the Commission and the standing 8 committees in the period between sine die and the 9 10 opening of the next legislative session. Proposed regulations can be drafted and reviewed by IRRC and 11 the Committees during this time. 12

13 Mr. Fritz noted the Board's pending proposed 14 rulemaking, Act 48, Citations and Civil Penalties. ] \* \* \* 15 16 Report of Commissioner - No Report \* \* \* 17 18 Report of Board President - No Report \* \* \* 19 20 [Pursuant to Section 708(a)(5) of the Sunshine Act, at 9:44 a.m. the Board entered into Executive Session 21 22 with William C.
