Haulman, President, Professional Member, 12 called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.] 13 \* \* \* 14 15 Introduction of Board Members, Staff, and Audience 16 [Daniel R. Haulman, President, Professional Member, requested the introduction of the Board members, 17 18 staff, and audience in attendance.] \* \* \* 19 20 Approval of minutes of the September 25, 2019 meeting 21 PRESIDENT HAULMAN: 2.2 We will start off with reviewing the 23 minutes from the last meeting. 24 Does anybody have any changes or 25 amendments that need to be made to

Professional and Occupational Affairs, announced that Capitol police will now be providing security for the building to be consistent with those of the Capitol Complex. He noted the public lobby hours to be 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., after which time everyone will need a badge to enter the building.

7 Acting Commissioner Johnson addressed the 8 transition to pa.gov email addresses. He announced 9 information technology (IT) was available for those 10 having difficulty with their email. He stated the 11 password protection, the 60-day scramble was not going 12 away as it is a security measure. He also noted the 13 authentication requirement was not going away either. 14 Acting Commissioner Johnson addressed working

15 with the Department of General Services to reinstitute 16 wall certificates and incorporate some type of digital 17 barcode or watermark that would allow members of the 18 public to scan and tie into the license verification 19 link and access disciplinary profiles.] 20 \* \* \* 21 [K. Kalonji Johnson, Acting Commissioner, Bureau of 2.2 Professional and Occupational Affairs, entered the 23 meeting at 9:47 a.m.]

25 Report of Board Counsel

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Sargent's Court Reporting Service, Inc. (814) 536-8908

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1 [C. William Fritz II, Esquire, Board Counsel, reviewed 2 the Act 41 draft. He noted that under (a)(1) the 3 language, "has a current license, certification, 4 registration, or permit" was not changed to avoid 5 confusion with other states. He mentioned the 6 jurisdiction the individual was coming from must be 7 substantially equivalent to Pennsylvania.

Mr. Fritz next referred to (a)(2), where 8 9 individuals must have practiced two of the last five 10 years. He discussed granting a provisional license 11 under Act 41 to individuals coming from another state 12 without certification. He stated the provisional 13 license would only be good for 12 months, unless the 14 applicant meets the requirements placed upon them in 15 order to receive a full license.

Mr. Fritz addressed other requirements, such as individuals cannot commit a violation of the act or regulations in another state, but stated the Board could to choose to issue an Act 41 license after conducting an informal conference with the applicant to find out more details about what happened in the other state.

Acting Commissioner Johnson stated the Policy
Office was working with the Department of Military and
Veterans Affairs to delve into areas where the

military has not been very good with certifying 1 classifications for training and duties. He mentioned 2 3 creating a crosswalk project for military 4 specifications to be matched with outside educational 5 requirements. Mr. Fritz discussed additional administrative 6 7 requirements. He had not yet drafted the preamble, 8 because there were not a lot of administrative 9 requirements other than proof of the certification and 10 proper submission of the application. 11 Mr. Fritz mentioned waiting on the Budget Office 12 regarding a fee analysis. 13 Mr. Fritz stated a termination provision was not 14 something the Board had to put in the regulation, 15 because it would be included in the order granting the 16 license itself. 17 Mr. Fritz commented that Ms. Li may flag an 18 application as having an issue and Board Counsel may 19 confirm the person did not qualify. The Board would 20 then have the opportunity to review the application 21 for possible Act 41 licensure. 2.2 Mr. Fritz will take the language to Regulatory 23 Counsel, but the final version will not go forward 2.4 without approval by the Board.] 25 \* \* \*
