With the 24 new PALS system, the reports will be customized for 25 each Board. He further explained the review process

She also noted an annual nuclear PE exam will be available in October 2018. It was noted that the new NCEES system glitches have been corrected.

Ms. Catania discussed an alternative pathway to the bachelor or master's Plus 30 position paper. She stated a task force was formed to clarify the B+30 requirement by developing language for the Model Law and Model Rules and creating guidelines for easier implementation by NCEES Member Boards.
