The Board entered into public session at 10:29 a.m.] 10 * * * 11 12 Meeting Instructions 13 [Kristel Hennessy Hemler, Board Administrator, 14 provided instructions to be followed during the 15 virtual meeting.] * * * 16 17 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State 18 Board of Funeral Directors was held on Wednesday, 19 March 30, 2022. Milian E.
