3 * * * 1 2 State Board of Massage Therapy 3 June 13, 2017 * * * 4 5 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State Board of 6 Massage Therapy Directors was held on Tuesday, June 7 13, 2017. Becky Lesik, LMT, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 9:40 a.m. Roll call was taken. 8 9 Shannon Baker, Secretary of Health Designee, was not 10 present at the commencement of the meeting. A quorum 11 was noted to be present. * * * 12 13 [Board members and staff were introduced, followed by 14 introductions from the audience.] * * * 15 16 Report of Prosecutorial Division 17 [Monty Batson, Esquire, Board Prosecution, presented 18 the following Consent Agreements: File No. 16-72-19 03608, File No. 15-72-02063, and File No. 17-72-20 02942.1 21 * * * 22 Approval of Minutes 23 [The Board discussed corrections to the March 28, 2017 24 meeting minutes.] 25 CHAIRPERSON LESIK:

4 We need a motion from the floor to 1 2 accept the minutes as amended? 3 MR. SMITH: So moved. 4 MS. BAUGHMAN: 5 6 Second. 7 CHAIRPERSON LESIK: 8 All those in favor? All those opposed? 9 Any abstentions? 10 [The motion carried unanimously.] * * * 11 Report of Board Regulatory Counsel 12 13 [Jacqueline Wolfgang, Esquire, Board Counsel, reviewed 14 the Regulation Status Report. 15 Ms. Wolfgang extensively reviewed the 16A-724 16 Fees, Proposed Preamble. She stated the Office of General Counsel submitted a memo with suggested 17 18 changes to the regulatory fees. 19 Ms. Wolfgang also updated the Board on the recent 20 evaluation by the Bureau of Financial Operations (BFO) 21 regarding the Board's proposed fees. In the initial 22 regulations, the Board proposed to increase the fee 23 for initial applications from \$65 to \$100, increase 24 the fee for CE to \$100, and increase the biannual fee 25 to \$200. BFO suggested a fee of \$190 for the initial

1 application and \$215 for continuing education. Ms.
2 Wolfgang made the Board aware of the BFO report in
3 order to provide an opportunity to revise the pending
4 regulations, if desired.

5 The Board discussed the pros and cons of pulling 6 back the proposed fee package and reworking the 7 regulatory package as compared to moving forward with 8 the regulatory package as proposed.

9 Chairperson Lesik questioned whether a delay in 10 processing the regulatory package would permit an 11 activation for the 2019 renewal. Ms. Waters informed 12 the Board the regulatory package generally takes two 13 years, if not longer. Ms. Wolfgang could not 14 guarantee that even the proposed regulatory package 15 will be published before the new renewal period.

16 Ms. Meyers questioned whether the fee for a 17 continuing education programmer was for every teaching 18 applicant or for every proposed class. Ms. Niner 19 stated the fee would apply to every class not on the preapproved list. The Board listed certain 20 21 preapproved providers that will not need to go through 22 the process as long as the class relates to massage 23 therapy. Ms. Niner clarified that a registered class 24 can teach any number of times.

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Ms. Wolfgang advised the Board on the

ramifications for revising or not revising the 1 regulations. She offered to touch base with the 2 3 Commissioner's office to determine whether the Board may move forward with the regulation as proposed. 4 Deputy Commissioner Waters agreed to push forward 5 6 with the regulation but had reservations for waiting 7 longer.] * * * 8 9 [Jacqueline Wolfgang, Esquire, Board Counsel, updated 10 the Board on 16A-725 Proposed Annex, General Revisions 11 regulation.] * * * 12 13 Report of Board Counsel 14 [Jacqueline Wolfgang, Esquire, Board Counsel, noted 15 the Status of Cases report for the Board's review. 16 She noted Adjudications and Orders, Records for 17 Deliberation, and matters for discussion during 18 Executive Session.] * * * 19 20 Miscellaneous 21 2017 FSMTB Annual Meeting 22 [Chairperson Lesik, informed the Board of a request of 23 the Commissioner's office regarding the annual (FSMTB) 2.4 Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards meeting.] * * * 25

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Updated BFO Report 1 [Ms. Wolfgang noted the updated BFO Report for the 2 Board's information. Ms. Niner stated that report 3 4 related to the fee report increases, which the Board 5 did not adopt, so another updated BFO report will be 6 provided at the Board's next meeting.] 7 * * * 8 House Bill No. 1488 9 [Natalie Cook, The Winter Group, addressed modifications to the professional licensure language. 10 Ms. Cook informed the Board of the CE waiver that had 11 12 been filed but not yet scheduled for committee consideration. 13 14 Chairperson Lesik discussed the addition of 15 individuals applying for licensure in the commonwealth 16 for the first time being exempted from the continuing education requirement for the biannual renewal period 17 18 following initial licensure.] * * * 19 2017 FSMTB Annual Meeting 20 21 [Chairperson Lesik informed the Board of an annual 22 FSMTB meeting in September in Tampa, Florida. She 23 mentioned the FSMTB website for resources. 24 Ms. Smith discussed the passage of resolutions 25 last year regarding the qualifications of a student to

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1 take the (MBLEx) Massage & Bodywork Licensing 2 Examination. She noted the deadline for resolutions as 3 July 1, 2017.

Ms. Smith discussed issues from the language of the MBLEx stating that a student merely needed to be enrolled in a massage therapy program before qualifying for MBLEx. Students were enrolled but had not yet completed their education.

9 There were also issues between states where 10 certain states were actually using the MBLEx as their 11 final testing for their schooling and the student had 12 not officially graduated. A couple of states were 13 upset because MBLEx was their final test, and if the 14 student failed, the student would continue their 15 education, address their deficiencies, and then let 16 the student take the test again. This permitted the 17 student to continue practicing or continue being 18 enrolled as a student before passing and obtaining 19 their licensure.

20 She stated the Policy Committee passed the 21 resolution mandating that a student must complete the 22 minimum hours required by their state before sitting 23 for the MBLEx. The final resolution passed with a 24 very large majority vote through the national 25 convention last year.]
