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3 * * * 1 2 State Board of Massage Therapy 3 September 18, 2017 * * * 4 5 The regularly scheduled meeting of the State Board of Massage Therapy was held on Monday, September 18, 2017. Becky Lesik, LMT, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m. Roll call was taken. A quorum was noted to be present. Gloria Rosado, LMT, Vice Chair, 10 was not present at the commencement of the meeting. * * * 11 12 [Board members and staff were introduced, followed by introductions from the audience. 1 13 * * * 14 15 Report of Prosecutorial Division [Adam Morris, Esquire, Board Prosecution, presented a 16 17 Consent Agreement for File No. 14-72-00456.] * * * 18 [Gloria Rosado, LMT, Vice Chair, entered the meeting 19 20 at 9:36 a.m.] * * * 21 22 [Monty Batson, Esquire, Board Prosecutor, presented a Consent Agreement for File No. 16-7204256.] 23 * * * 24 25 Presentation

[Katelin Lambert, Director of Operation, Bureau of 1 2 Professional and Occupational Affairs, provided a 3 demonstration on the online PALS system. She reviewed the system for the initial application process; 5 however, she pointed out that there is a different process for current licensees. The Board discussed enhancing communications with schools to inform all of the PALS system.] 10 Approval of Minutes of the August 8, 2017 meeting CHAIRPERSON LESIK: 11 12 I would ask for any additions or 13 corrections that anybody noticed. 14 [The Board discussed corrections to the minutes.] 15 CHAIRPERSON LESIK: 16 I'd like to have a motion to approve the August 8, 2017 draft minutes with a 17 correction noted. 18 19 MS. 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4 Report of Board Counsel

[Jacqueline Wolfgang, Esquire, noted two proposed Adjudications and Orders, eleven applications and two Consent Agreements for discussion in Executive Session.

Ms. Wolfgang noted the Regulatory Status Report for the Board's review. There were no updates. She noted that a regulatory meeting will be scheduled in December.

Ms. Wolfgang suggested that the Board review the Status of Cases Report.

She offered a Delaware County Common Pleas Court case for the Board's review. The name of the case is State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company vs.
Robert J. Cavoto. The court ruled that chiropractors may delegate certain duties to unlicensed personnel as long as the duties do not require a license or formal training. She suggest the Board review the case and the student practice regulations to determine whether the Board needs to clarify the student practice in chiropractic offices.]

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1 Report of Chairperson

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[Becky Lesik, LMT, Chair, requested that Jamie Smith, LMT, review the FSMTB Resolutions.

Jamie Smith, LMT, provided a synopsis of the resolutions. The Policy Committee reviewed the resolutions. The first resolution wanted guidelines on how to run elections for FSMTB Board of Directors. She opined that a hard and fast election structure could limit the FSMTB and affect diversity on the Board. She also noted that this change was closer in nature to being an amendment rather than a resolution.

The second resolution related to access to information before the meetings. She noted that FSMTB gets information to its delegates as soon as possible. She also noted that information regarding voting and decision-making was provided well in advance of the 17 meetings.

The third resolution concerned MBLEx examination centers in rural locations. She noted that the FSMTB would like to have testing centers in rural locactions; however, the rural locations, such as community colleges, cannot provide the necessary security required for the MBLEx.

Ms. Smith noted that the Policy Committee had a Do Not Pass recommendation on all three resolutions.]
