## Termination of a Collaborative Agreement or Prescriptive Authority Collaborative Agreement

## • Important Information

- If the existing collaborative agreement <u>does not</u> provide information regarding another physician in the same group or practice who has agreed to provide interim coverage for up to 30 days (as per Section 18.9 of the regulations), you cannot fulfill the requirements to practice.
- A nurse-midwife may not practice without having a collaborative agreement registered with the Board.
- o A nurse-midwife prescriptive authority certificate <u>will be placed on inactive status</u> if there are no other collaborative agreements with prescriptive authority on file.
- Failure of a nurse-midwife to notify the Board within 30 days of a termination of the collaborative physician/nurse-midwife relationship is a basis for disciplinary action against the nurse midwife's license.
- The termination can be initiated by either the collaborating physician or nurse-midwife.
  - Locate the relationship in the Relationship/Association section of your PALS dashboard. Next to the relationship, click on the green edit pencil.
- You will need to confirm that you are terminating the relationship. The relationship will be terminated as soon as you confirm.
- An email confirming the relationship has been terminated will be sent to both the collaborating physician and nurse-midwife.
