Auxiliary Personnel Registration

Effective Immediately, the State Boards of Chiropractic, Dentistry, Medicine, Osteopathic Medicine and Podiatry are no longer registering auxiliary personnel or otherwise issuing documents authorizing auxiliary personnel to apply ionizing radiation in the offices of licensees. In accordance with the law and regulations of the Boards, auxiliary personnel who wish to perform radiologic procedures are required to pass an exam approved by the relevant Board, or obtain certification by one of the following organizations, as set forth in the applicable Board's regulations. To verify that an individual has passed one of the approved examinations or is certified, the auxiliary personnel should be able to provide documentation or you should contact the exam provider/certifying organization as follows:
