Ms. Miller addressed changes to the National Council Licensure Examinations® (NCLEX®) effective October 1, where the 15 pretest questions will be reintroduced with test takers having to complete a minimum of 75 items and maximum of 145 to be completed in 5 hours.

13 Ms. Miller mentioned an option for test takers to 14 complete a voluntary Next Generation NCLEX® Research 15 She noted a link on the Board's website for section. 16 NCLEX® information through the National Council of 17 State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN). She stated all 18 Pennsylvania testing sites are open and following 19 safety precautions. She recommended that applicants 20 awaiting to test should check back with Pearson VUE 21 periodically for test openings.
