7 Linda L. Kmetz, PhD, RN, Chairperson, called the
8 meeting to order at 9:21 a.m. Ian J. Harlow,
9 Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs,
10 was not present at the commencement of the meeting.

11 Dr. Kmetz reviewed the emergency evacuation
12 procedures for One Penn Center.

8 Report of Commissioner

9 [Ian J. Harlow, Commissioner of Professional and
10 Occupational Affairs, addressed the problems Board
11 members were having with accessing their Commonwealth
12 email. He updated the Board on the PALS project in
13 relation to license renewals. He also noted that the
14 ability to access files in that system was still
15 roughly three to four months away.

16 Commissioner Harlow discussed name changes on
17 driver's licenses. A name change made with PennDOT
18 before being made with the Department of State will be
19 verified against PennDOT with an instant name change.
20 Commissioner Harlow stated this process will not be
21 available until the beginning of the year.

22 Commissioner Harlow informed the Board of
23 Governor Wolf's Executive Order requiring a thorough
24 review of licensing practices, which includes the
25 comparison of 255 license types in 50 different

1 states. He stated the Board will be able to review
2 the report and make recommendations after the report
3 is issued to the Governor.]

20 Appointment

21 Pennsylvania Association of Practical Nursing
22 Administrators Presentation

23 [Janyce L. Collier, MSN, RN, CNE, President,
24 Pennsylvania Association of Practical Nursing
25 Administrators, presented a paper titled Front and

1 Center, which highlights the role, trends and the
2 future of licensed practical nursing in Pennsylvania.

3 Ms. Collier stated the paper was written by Dr.
4 Linda Rhodes, former Pennsylvania Secretary of Aging,
5 who is very knowledgeable of the aging population in
6 this state. She commented that Pennsylvania has the
7 largest elderly population in rural areas, and that by
8 the year 2030, Texas will have the largest shortage of
9 LPNs, followed by Pennsylvania.

10 Ms. Collier referred to statistical information
11 for further discussion on the matter. She stated the
12 Institute of Medicine in its Future of Nursing report
13 identified that nursing needs to become more diverse.
14 Ms. Collier indicated there are 57 practical nursing
15 programs and 52,000 licensed practical nurses in
16 Pennsylvania with an average salary of \$42,000 a
17 year.]

18

19 [Kimberly Delbo, Director, Central Susquehanna LPN
20 Career Center, discussed the continuing education
21 requirements for nurses across the nation. She stated
22 90 percent of states have equitable requirements for
23 RNs and LPNs, and Pennsylvania is the only state that
24 does not require continuing education outside of the
25 required child abuse education for practical nurses.

1 Ms. Delbo asked the Board to consider requiring
2 continuing education for licensed practical nurses in
3 the Commonwealth. She posited that licensed practical
4 nurses would be more valued if they were held to the
5 same standard as registered nurses and requiring
6 continuing education for licensed practical nurses
7 would benefit patients.

8 Ms. Pachter Schulder noted that Commissioner
9 Harlow had just addressed a recent Executive Order
10 which would review, amongst other factors, the
11 requirements for continuing education. Ms. Pachter
12 Schulder further noted a statute change is required in
13 order to mandate continuing education.]

14 ***

15 Legislative Update/Advanced Practice Committee
16 [Donald Bucher, DNP, ACNP-BC, FCCP, represented the
17 Pennsylvania Coalition of Nurse Practitioners, which
18 is a statewide organization that helps promote change
19 to legislation on behalf of CRNPs. Mr. Bucher
20 discussed the passage of Senate Bill 25, as amending
21 CRNP provisions in the Professional Nursing Law. The
22 House version, House Bill 100, is before the
23 Professional Licensure Committee. He referred to the
24 3-year, 3600-hour transition as a compromise.
25 Liability insurance was also discussed.]

1 ***

2 [Mary Lou Taylor, CRNA, BSN, Secretary, Pennsylvania
3 Association of Nurse Anesthetists, discussed the
4 passage of Senate Bill 274 regarding certified nurse
5 anesthetists. The companion bill in the House, House
6 Bill 719, is before the Professional Licensure
7 Committee. She noted opposition to House Bill 789,
8 addressing the administration of anesthesia,
9 introduced by Representative Christiana of Beaver
10 County, and referred to it as a "setback."

11 Ms. Taylor discussed Shinal v. Toms, the
12 Pennsylvania Supreme Court decision on informed
13 consent involving physicians and physician assistants
14 and its implications on nurse anesthetists and nurse
15 practitioners.]

16 ***

17 [Mary Marshall, Director, Workforce & Professional
18 Services, Hospital & Healthsystem Association of
19 Pennsylvania, thanked Commissioner Harlow for working
20 with HAP to assist with the utilization of the PALS
21 system.

22 Ms. Marshall stated HAP supports House Bill 100
23 but opposes House Bill 789.]

24 Behalf of the Board

25 [Chairperson Kmetz reported on the NCSBN meeting of

1 the Standards Development Committee on September 25
2 and September 26, 2017, in Chicago, wherein the
3 Committee discussed exemptions from licensure,
4 including a state of emergency or if a disaster is
5 declared.

6 Ms. Kmetz stated the Committee is reviewing
7 standards for alternative programs for monitoring
8 nurses with substance abuse disorders as well as a
9 standard for state-to-state agreements for
10 endorsements for a nurse in a monitoring program in
11 another state.

12 Also being reviewed is primary source
13 verification of licensure, renewal questions related
14 to criminal convictions or disciplinary actions by
15 Boards, and national nursing accreditation for nursing
16 programs. She mentioned three major accrediting
17 agencies, including the newly-created NLN, ACEN and
18 CCNE, being reviewed by the stakeholders.

19 Chairperson Kmetz reviewed her work on the
20 standards for nursing education programs.]

21

22 Report of Executive Secretary

23 [Laurette Keiser, MSN, RN, Executive Secretary, noted
24 Tuesday, October 31, 2017 as the renewal expiration
25 date. She referred Board members to the agenda for

1 information on the NCSBN website regarding an opioid
2 toolkit.]

5 [Chairperson Kmetz noted agenda items concerning
6 Registered Nurse First Assistant and NCSBN's Proposed

21 referred the Board to documentation about the Supply
22 and Demand of the Nursing Workforce as an extension of
23 the discussion from the last meeting.]

25 [Dr. Petula reported the annual results of the NCLEX

1 examinations are being compiled and reviewed but
2 stated both the RN and PN Programs improved over last
3 year's scores. She will provide a report at the next
4 meeting. Dr. Petula mentioned the RN Programs
5 improved close to 4 percentage points, which is above
6 91 percent, and both the RN programs and PN programs
7 are above the U.S. national average.

8 In terms of releasing the data to the programs in
9 light of the Board's December meeting date, Ms.
10 Pachter Schulder provided the following three options
11 regarding Dr. Petula's report: (1) Release the
12 information to Board members a few days in advance of
13 the website posting followed by a discussion at the
14 December meeting; (2) Release all of the information
15 after the Board's discussion at its December meeting;
16 and (3) Release the data to the programs as soon as it
17 is completed. Board members favored option three.]

22 Jefferson University Department of Nursing - Request
23 for Extension of Interim Program Director
24 [Ann Phalen, PhD, CRNP, NNP-BC, Interim Dean &
25 Associate Professor, Thomas Jefferson University,

1 Jefferson College of Nursing and Mark L. Tykocinski,
2 MD, Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic
3 Affairs, Thomas Jefferson University, introduced
4 themselves to the Board. Ann Michele Coughlin, MBA,
5 MSN, RN, Vice Chair, recused herself from the
6 discussion.

7 Dr. Tykocinski discussed the letter to the Board
8 regarding the extension of Dr. Phalen's term beyond
9 the 12-month period due to a longer than anticipated
10 search for the administrator position. Dr. Tykocinski
11 provided a history of the search committee and noted
12 the appointment of the search firm of Heidrick &
13 Struggles to create a position specification. He
14 reported two of seven individuals recommended by the
15 committee were invited to two days of interviews but
16 neither were found to be the right fit for the
17 position.

18 Dr. Tykocinski noted the merger of Thomas
19 Jefferson University with Philadelphia University.
20 The position description was then updated to reflect
21 the new status. He stated two interviews are
22 scheduled for early November. Dr. Tykocinski
23 indicated the October letter was submitted due to the
24 concern that a new dean might not be in place by
25 January 1, 2018; and, therefore, the request for the

1 extension until September 1, 2018.]

4 Administration of Buprenorphine by CRNPs

5 [Judith Pachter Schulder, Esquire, Board Counsel,

6 noted the Board's position, posted on its website,

7 with regard to the prescription of Suboxone by CRNPs.

8 She advised the Board cannot provide any advisory

9 opinions but referred to Section 21.284(d)(2) of the

10 regulations which states that if it is part of the

11 collaborative agreement that CRNPs with prescriptive

12 authority can prescribe Schedule III controlled

13 substances for a 90-day period.

14 Ms. Pachter-Schulder stated the Board received a

15 letter from the American Society of Addiction Medicine

16 and the American Association of Nurse Practitioners

17 who inquired if there was a way to ensure that CRNPs

18 and physician assistants are permitted to prescribe

19 buprenorphine if the licensee has a waiver. It was

20 noted the Commissioner would write a letter on behalf

21 of both Boards. She will refer the Commissioner to

22 the Board's website posting.]
