Dr. McAleer commented that the Board approved schools accredited by another body at a recent meeting and noted that those accredited schools should also have a residency. He agreed that it is misleading.

Dr. Spayd offered to contact the office of the document to provide an update. She addressed where it read practicum hours can be considered for licensure, noting it does not say at a minimum of 15 hours a week and asked whether the Board should request more specificity for that item as well.

Dr. McAleer noted that to be a little different, because they do accept practicum but there are many details involved. He did not believe they needed to specify at a higher level of detail, because it is just giving a statement that practicum is considered but up to them to apply the detail.]
