She noted no repercussions with insurance 6 companies because the bill does not require any 7 insurance to reimburse. Mr. Fritz informed Ms. Baturin that the 8 9 Department will move forward with the process of 10 analyzing the legislation.] * * * 11 12 Old Business [Donald McAleer, Psy.D., Professional Member, 13 14 questioned whether there had been any movement 15 regarding prior discussion about a relationship 16 between a new law and existing Board regulations 17 regarding supervised time for licensure.
